We are Mass of Life Hosts

In place of our regular meeting on January 21st., we have been invited by the Right to Life Group of Visitation BVM to act as hosts and participants for a special Mass of Life. This Tuesday night we will have Knights serving as ushers and provide refreshments after the Mass in the Larkin Center.

This is on the eve of the anniversary of the court decision "Roe v. Wade" that allowed abortion to become legal. The next day many will join the March in Washington to protest this national shame. Many here will be involved in special prayer vigils and other activities. At Saint Teresa there will be a day of Prayer and Eucharistic Adoration for Respect for All Life - beginning at 8 AM until 7 PM with a Rosary for Life at 6:30 PM before the Benediction

MILESTONES IN THE CRUSADE FOR LIFE

Even before the U.S. Supreme Court's 1973 *Roe vs. Wade* decision, the Knights of Columbus had positioned itself as a leader in the pro-life movement. In the fall of 1972, the Knights went to work with other pro-life groups to combat abortion. Its opposition to abortion is a pledge the Order has proudly kept for a quarter of a century of milestones in the Crusade for Life
