The seed is planted lets pray that individuals will step forward to join us. If you know of someone that would make a good brother knight please let Brother Dale know.



Several hundred members of the Catholics United for Life of North Texas, Inc. gathered at Planned Parenthood in Fort Worth on Good Friday, March 29, 2013, to pray for babies and their mothers.

Ten decades were prayed for each of the twenty mysteries of the rosary; joyful, luminous, sorrowful, and glorious.

Included in the Priests who led the rosaries were Rev. Monsignor Stephen J. Berg, Diocesan Administrator; Rev. Monsignor Michael Olson, Rector of Holy Trinity Seminary; and Rev. Michael Moloney, Parochial Vicar.
