In March the Trustees will be looking to form a slate of Officers to vote on for the next fiscal year.

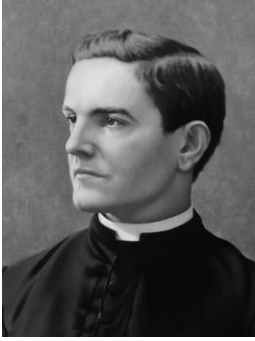
If you are thinking of holding an office please talk to one of them. May 11<sup>th</sup> will be our Annual Garage sale.

## TWO NATURES, ONE PERSON



Jesus plainly showed the "twoness" of his natures by doing things only God can do (such as raising the dead to life) and things that men must commonly do (e.g., eating, sleeping, drinking, etc.).

Yet, equally plainly, He also showed the "oneness" of His personality. He did not say to the widow's son, for example, "the God part of me says to thee, Arise!". Jesus commanded simply, "I say to thee, Arise!". On the Cross, Jesus did not say, "My human nature thirsts", instead He cried out, "I thirst": Two natures, one Person.
