When you least expect it, the months just fly by. In a matter of days we will be starting the season of Lent on Ash Wednesday, March 5th. Have we prepared ourselves to strengthen our relationship with Our Lord and Redeemer during the weeks before Easter?

Another thought for you to think about is something I read in the Magnificat written by Rev. Peter John Cameron, O.P., ““The season of Lent is once again upon us! Pope Francis speaks of Lent as “a shout of truth and certain hope” In Lent we are invited “to undertake a Paschal road toward Life, a path that includes the cross and resignation; a path that will be uncomfortable but not fruitless. We are invited to admit that something inside us is not going well, to change, to turn around, to be converted.” We thank God for the grace and the mercy of this holy road. Let us pray for each other along our Lenten way to Calvary and the empty tomb.””

During the beginning of this Lenten

season, we will also be celebrating three feast days; the first is St. Patrick’s Day on March the 17th. Happy St. Patrick’s Day to you and your Families. The second is St. Joseph’s Day on March 19th who is the patron saint of workers and most important of Fathers. I received a prayer from Franciscan Mission that I would like to share with you. “Gracious St. Joseph protect me and my family from all evil as you did the Holy Family. Kindly keep us ever united in the love of Christ, ever fervent in imitation of the virtue of our Blessed Lady, your sinless spouse, and always faithful in devotion to you. Amen.” The third feast is the feast of the Annunciation of the Lord on March 25th.

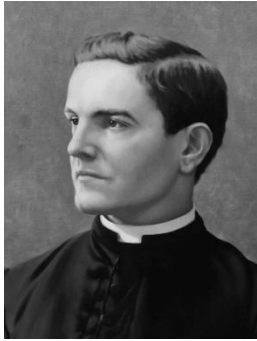
