# **Grand Knights Report**

Second, this year Pope Benedict XVI has declared the "Year of Faith", starting October 11, 2012 to November 24, 2013. 
paper work. 4<sup>th</sup> degree is Patriotism in the Order.


SK John Young was chosen as <u>Knight of the</u> <u>Year</u> by General Worth Assembly 1089.

Just to update you on the recent events, the Hole in one contest on the Par 3's has just gotten better.


Jerry's Buick is offering a 2012 Buick Lacrosse to the first individual to get a hole in one on

O Merciful Mother, give us the courage to reject the culture of death and the strength to build a new Culture of Life. *Amen*.




# Supreme Knight urges all Knights to vote and help to "Get Out the Vote" on election day
