To those who have answered the call for support I Thank You.

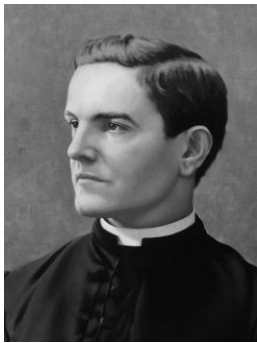

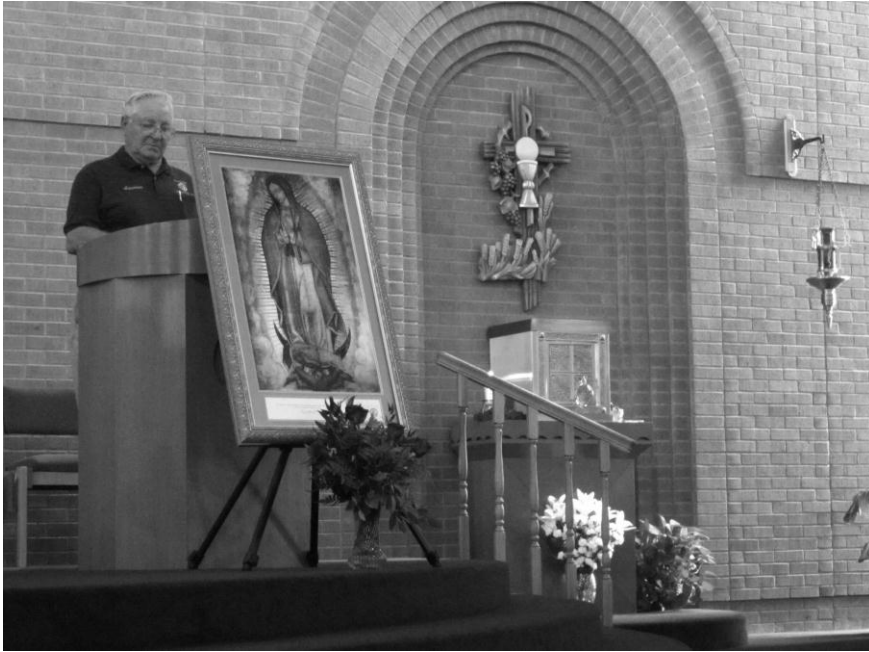
