# **CHAPLAIN'S REPORT**

Lent is the period of fasting leading up to the period of Easter, recalling Jesus' 40-day fast in the wilderness. Ash Wednesday signifies the start of Lent and on this day, ashes from burnt palm branches are blessed, mixed with either holy water, and marked on the head with the sign of the cross.

When the priest imposes the ashes he says either "remember man you are dust, and to dust you will return" (see Genesis 3:19). The ashes serve a dual purpose. First, we are reminded of our mortality. Second, the ashes are a Biblical symbol of repentance, sorrow, and humility.

There are two guiding principles for the observance of Lent. During this season, the faithful are to grow in their love of Jesus Christ and they are to practice extra penance for their own and other people's sins.

Whatever you decide to fast from, remember "Lent is more than a diet." Lent is about spiritual results, not material ones. So, while losing a few pounds may be a nice side benefit, all fasting should be done for God's glory and spiritual growth.
