Dear Brother Knights,



As many of you know, I was not always a faithful practicing Catholic. When I returned to a life of following the Church, it dawned on me that I had been shooting myself in the foot all those years.

The Church knew better than I did. I had been missing out on the peace, love, and happiness that being reconciled to God and being in right relationship with Him brings. In other words, I experienced the truth of these words of Jesus: "I have said these things to you so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete." (John 15:11) Jesus wants us to be happy - to

have, as Pope Francis says, "the joy of the Gospel."

This joy and happiness of God comes into our lives, and that of our families, only when we are in right relationship with God. "My peace I leave you, my peace I give you."

Jesus said to His apostles, "If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." (John 20:23) Through apostolic succession and ordination, every Catholic priest has this power. "Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:28). Don't miss out on the beautiful blessings of peace, love, and joy you are waiting for. Come to Jesus in this beautiful Sacrament of Reconciliation, and you will never regret it.
