Our NEW website is up and running and easier than ever to access!

Our former website has been discontinued for information purposes but we have retained the URL which allows the opportunity to still type in www.kofcancaster.ca and be redirected to the new website.

This is an easier method for current and future Knights as well as the general public to access our information to discover the rich history and community spirit of our Council.

The URL for the new website is <u>http://uknight.org/CouncilSite/?</u> <u>CNO=10009</u> which is a much more difficult "handle" to remember but will also work as a means of access directly.

When you first type in www.kofcancaster.ca into your browser you may be presented with an error message about the site being unsafe. Please ignore that message and click on Advanced features or Continue Anyway. If you have a VPN service running on your computer you may need to temporarily disable it the first time you try to access the www.kofcancaster.ca URL as it is redirecting and the VPN is seeing this as malicious. However, immediately after accessing the website you can restore your VPN and will be able to login every time after that with the VPN running. Of course the best thing to do is Bookmark the www.kofcancaster.ca website and place it at the top of your browser so that you can access it easily and often. As the new website continues to be populated you are encouraged to check back frequently to see what new initiatives we are undertaking. Hopefully this will enrich your experience as a Knight and make it easier to stay informed. Finally, PLEASE click on Website Walk-Through Video as well as the Members Only tab to sign in and update your personal information. Dress code for the candidates is the new Fourth Degree Uniform, or a regular dark suit, white shirt and dark tie or a regular tuxedo, plain white pleated front tuxedo shirt with regular lay-down shirt collar and black bow tie. No shirt with a stand up collar allowed. Black shoes and socks are also required. Members of the Clergy and Deacons should wear their clerical garb.

Members of the Armed Forces, Police Officers and Fire-fighters dressed in Class A dress uniform shall be considered in proper attire for all Exemplification events.

Lecturer's Talk: Michael Creaghan

Peace



Pax Vobiscum - At the end of Mass - go in peace - peace be in your heart and soul

Peace be with you - we wish this to our family and neighbour at the communion during Mass

Shalom - Jewish salutation that peace be within oneself, one's family and neighbour

As-salaam Alaikum (a-lay-kum) - Muslim salutation that peace be upon you

For 73 years there has been no peace in Israel and the Middle East. And as things are progressing there will be no peace in Israel for another 73 years.

Most Palestinians and most Israelis want peace and to live in harmony with each other. They realize that this can only come about with a two state solution. There have been countless peace negotiations with no success. Muslim terrorists and ultra right wing Jewish factions don't want peace. How can one claim to be a good Muslim or Jew and still want to kill the other? Where is SHALOM and where is AS-SALAAM ALAIKUM? Does life have so little value that when a Palestinian terrorist kills an Israeli Jew the Israeli army kills 20 Palestinians. Israel on a per capita basis has the strongest military force in the world. Israel also has nuclear weapons. It is very unlikely that the major arms manufacturers want peace.

Do we blame this on religion? Possibly the majority of Israelis are culturally Jewish but don't practice their faith. This is also true of most of the western people who are culturally Christian but don't practice their religion. With Muslims it may be different as their religion is both a belief and a way of life. All three of these religions and cultures are descendants of Abraham who believed there was but one God. At least this can be a starting position to peace negotiations.

With too many of the leaders on both sides there was, and there is, no intention in finding a peaceful solution . Their intentions were, and are, to maintain their power through corruption, greed, glory, fear, apprehension and miss information. The leaders of Hamas wanted war in order to keep control over its bitter rival the Palestinian Authority. Hamas claims to be the only true voice of the Palestinian people. Hamas now claims victory for it has now stopped Israeli expansion. A great victory even though hundreds of women and children were killed, buildings were blown up and most infrastructure destroyed. Hamas controls through fear and intimidation.

They speak for themselves and, in reality, don't care at all about the Palestinian people. Now look at Israeli prime minister Benjamin Netanyahu. He is in deep trouble. He cannot form a government, and he is being investigated on corruption charges which could send him to jail.

Why not start a little war to divert the heat away from himself. He claims he wants peace but will not negotiate with a terrorist organization. (The PLO before were also considered another terrorist organization.) Israeli settlement on disputed land and the attack on the Al-Aqsa Mosque by Israeli police gave Hamas the justification to fire 4000 inaccurate rockets at Israeli settlements. Hamas still has 8000 rockets at war's end. A prominent Israeli journalist, Adam Raz, wrote of Netanyahu and Hamas that the war should be seen "not as a war between enemies but a collaboration between colleagues." (since writing this there has been a coalition among minority parties in the Knesset forcing Netanyahu out of office.)

Any peace in the Middle East is fragile. The majority of Palestinians and Israelis want peace which can only come through a two state solution. Most of the rest of the world wants peace.

The Americans, the British and the UN have all tried to help and failed and have failed for over 70 years.

It may be time to look at a totally novel solution. Everything up to now was done for control, power, glory and greed. Men looking after their own self interest. The result was total failure.

PUT THE NEGOTIATIONS IN THE HANDS OF ISRAELI MOTHERS AND PALESTINIAN MOTHERS. This may sound ridiculous but think again. Mothers first priority is the protection and safety of their children and grandchildren. Mothers are not motivated by power and glory to the same extent as men. Mothers' motivations are harmony and peace.
