

Note New Time for Monthly Membership Meetings – Second Tuesdays 7:30PM

The Council voted on Feb. 20, 2020 to move the monthly membership meetings to the 2^{nd} Tuesday of the month at 7:30PM, starting on March 10. The Council had also voted at the Dec. 2019 meeting to hold a drawing at the end of each calendar year, for members who attend the monthly meetings (2^{nd} Tuesdays @ 7:30PM). Your name is entered once for each of 12 meetings that you attend, so your chances of taking home the \$300 increases with each meeting you attend! You must attend the whole meeting to have your name entered. Meetings typically last 30-45 minutes. Our council also has 2 Masses said at St. Mary Church, unless the family wants these Masses at a different parish. We have members available to serve the Mass at St. Mary for a funeral. Please advise Fr. George when making arrangements, he will notify us.
