Service Program Personnel

We continue to perform many of the activities that would fall under these programs (Breakfasts, Bingo, Spelling Bee, Baby Shower, FT contest, Keep Christ in Christmas, Thanksgiving Turkeys, IDD drive, etc.), we just don't have directors listed. Much work is already being done, we just need folks willing to take the titles and monitor or grow efforts. And we MUST have someone who has taken the "Safe Environment" training at any event in which kids are present! See below a brief description of the responsibilities:

<u>Program Director</u>: Provides council leadership with guidance & direction on council programming. Collaborates with the GK in setting calendar of council programs. Manages each category's program directors (Community, Family, Faith, and Life) and chairmen as they implement the council's programs.

<u>Community Director</u>: Directs programs that support and encourage service to the community to fight poverty, aid the individual, promote athletic events, and sponsor larger programs and campaigns. <u>Family Director</u>: Works to strengthen and nourish wholesome home life through sponsorship of activities involving entire families.

<u>Faith Director</u>: Plans faith formation activities for the council. Develops ties with other parish ministries to advance the needs of the whole parish community at the pastor's direction.
