

Bob went from rags to riches to rags without becoming bitter or lessening his commitment to helping others. Bob suffered and did not complain. Bob was always looking to help others less fortunate than himself.

I wish I had more time to know this resourceful and creative man better. There are many he helped here and I strongly suspect that if there are jobs to do in Heaven, we'll find our Brother Bob on guard just inside the door.
