## Frequently Asked Questions

### *Q. Why Should I Make this Retreat?*

*A.* When is the last time you spent time alone with the Lord? Do you feel as if you are running on empty? If your spiritual life is secondary to your daily life, a retreat will help to restore balance to your life. It is virtually a time-out with God, self and others. Regardless of your personal spiritual walk today, for many the retreat may be a life-changing experience. Just ask one of the men who have made a retreat! Whether you have an active spiritual life or, you may be a prodigal son desiring to return to your faith, consider making this retreat.

### *Q. Why does the retreat not last until Sunday?*

*A.* We have purposely structured our retreat to be family friendly. We have designed it to maximize the benefits of a retreat and minimize the time away from your family, in this way you are still able to spend quality time with your family on that same weekend. ### *Q. What Happens on the Retreat?*

*A.* During our men's retreats, the schedule is pre-set. The retreat consists of Mass, several talks by our Retreat Leader, and time for private confession, reflection and adoration. *Saint Benedict Center, an oasis of peace in the midst of Nebraska's corn and bean fields, is a non-profit, ecumenical retreat and conference center founded by the Missionary Benedictines of Christ the King Priory. As Benedictines they share their hospitality and spirituality with those who search for personal and spiritual growth. They provide an atmosphere that is conducive to prayer, rest, and renewal for laity, clergy, and religious.*

*The facility sits on 160 acres of farm land across the road from Christ the King Priory in Schuyler. They offer a place of retreat for seekers of God and for people who are tired of living in a noisy world and want to be alone in order to listen to the Lord. The facility offers a conference center and 100 beds for overnight stays of one night or several nights.*
