The Laws and Rules Governing the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus, dated February 2008, have changed the time requirement. It now reads: "A Third Degree member in good standing in his Council and who was initiated in the Admission (First) Degree at least six months prior to his initiation in the Fourth Degree" may become a Fourth Degree Knight. This time requirement was changed again with Resolution Number 2012-09 as such: It has been approved that the six month waiver is no longer required for a Third Degree member in good standing to become a Fourth Degree member. This change will be noted in the next revised Laws and Rules Governing the Fourth Degree.

The candidates must also have received their Second and Third Degrees. This Exemplification is supported by 2nd and 3rd Degree Knights of St. Anne De Beaupre Council 3157.
