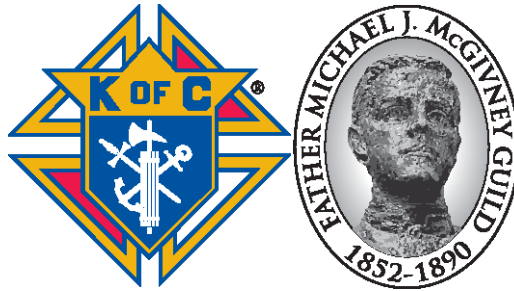

Brother Financial Secretaries and/or Grand Knights,

It is time for three important items of business to be accomplished: State Per Capita, State Convention Delegate Credentials and Compilation of Deceased Brother Knights for the past year. Every council in the State needs to accomplish these three items no later than March 31, 2016.

STATE PER CAPITA:

The Per Capita worksheets list your State Per Capita taxation per Resolution #1. Make checks payable to Arkansas State Council Knights of Columbus or ASC Knights of Columbus and mail along with the worksheet to Philip Savage, State Secretary (See address below). Per capita and donations must be mailed in by **March 31st**. Per Capita must be paid before your delegates will be allowed to vote at the convention.

It is most important that your Pennies from Heaven Fund donation be generous. In past years, we have made donations to needy families for more than what was taken in. This was possible only because of a small surplus from several years ago. We will not be able to do this much longer without your generous donations.

DELEGATE CREDENTIALS:

Each Council should elect two (2) delegates and two (2) alternate delegates to the State Convention. Delegates should be Grand Knights or Past Grand Knights, if GK or PGKs are not able to attend; any 3rd Degree Knight may represent the council. Delegate and Alternate forms need to be filled out, sealed with the council seal and the originals returned to Philip Savage, State Secretary (See address below) by **March 31st**. Delegates and alternates need to have their copy of their Credentials with them when they sign in at the convention.

COMPILATION OF DECEASED MEMBERS:

Please submit a list of any Brother Knights from your council who have passed away since the last State Convention by **March 31st**. A statewide list will be prepared and read at the State Council Memorial Mass during the State Convention in Little Rock. If you have any deaths in your council after the March 31st cut off, please email me for their inclusion. I would encourage your council's delegation to attend the State Council Memorial Mass on Sunday morning at the State Convention, as each council shall read the names of their council's deceased members.

Thank you in advance and I will see you at the convention in Hot Springs.

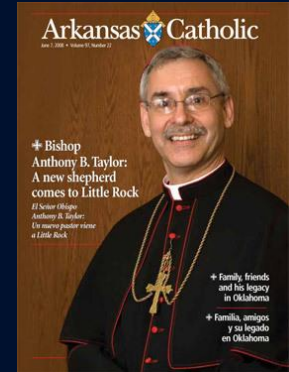
