This will be a review of the 6-step process introduced at the Diocesan meetings: Invitation, Confirmation, Information, Application, Exemplification, and Participation, with a special focus on steps 2 and 3, Confirmation and Information.



FIRST THINGS FIRST!

- Deepen your relationship with Father
 - Meet with him spend time listen
- Make his parish goals your goals
- Align your programs to serve the goals of your parish or parishes, and do not spend time and energy on programs that divert from parish goals
- This is the foundation on which we will build our order.

THE SCHEDULE

- Get Father's permission to invite families before Masses one weekend
- Give Father the pulpit announcement for review
- Contact your GA
- Schedule the Confirmation calls within 48 hours of the Invitation



THE SCHEDULE

- Host the Information meeting about 10 days after the Invitation
- The Application is filled out at the close of the Information meeting
- Hold the Exemplification in less than two weeks
- Hold it on a meeting night *designed* to begin the Participation of the new members



- Invite them to what? To learn more about the Knights and how we help Father accomplish their parish goals
- With what? Materials 921-A and 2595
- Who invites? Council members AND Knights from other councils

Why Knights from other councils?

No inhibitions, they ask everyone!



- When? Before Mass Knights need to arrive a half hour early
- If Father permits, include a pulpit announcement

Model in brochure 10067 and on State Website

Ideally 5 minutes before Mass

THE CONFIRMATION

- Who will call to confirm?
- What personality are you looking for?
- Have the callers arranged *before* you invite!
- When will they call?
- Within 48 hours of the invitation!
- Why within 48 hours?



THE CONFIRMATION

• What will they say? (example only, make it your own!) with the Knights of Hello, (name), this is Columbus. Thank you for taking the time to share your contact information with my Brother Knight at the (time) Mass (day) at (parish). I am calling to invite you to learn more about the role of the Knights at (parish). (Name), to help us prepare, how many family members or friends will you be bringing with you? Can we count on you being there?



THE CONFIRMATION

There are two calls!!

• Call again the night before the information event

"Hello, (name), this is _____ with the Knights of Columbus. Because we know how busy life is, this is just a friendly reminder about that information session tomorrow evening. We have you down for (number). Is that correct?

Thank you and may God Bless you. We look forward to seeing you (time) tomorrow evening at (place). Can we count on you being there?"

Setting up the room

- Head table for Father, Presenter, Panel
- Tables for Knights and guests
- Table with coloring books, etc. for children
- Set up a couple of tables short
- Have Projector or wide screen TV available



Setting up the room

- Have plenty of Council Knights on hand to be proposers (the inviters and callers)
- Council Knights should arrive a half hour early
- Scatter through the room, leaving space at tables
- Have finger food on the tables
- Offer soda/water/juice/coffee to guests as they arrive



- Brief welcome
- Opening prayer and remarks by Father
- Brief video to show you one aspect of Knighthood that is not widely publicized

Point out prayer booklets, cards in folder
 (Do NOT pass out folders!)



Explanation of the process

By being here you are taking the second step toward Knighthood in our Order. You took the first step when you chose to give our Brother Knight your name and phone number so we could invite you here. The remaining steps are:

Filling out an application (you will be given one – show folder)
Application review by our admission committee and by Father
Welcoming ceremony for you and your family!

- Point out the council brochure in the folder



Questions/Answers Time

- Meeting times/dates
- Dues (optional beginning second year)
- Invite to participate in next activities
- Invite any other questions
- Pass out folders theirs to keep
- Point out the simple application form



Show Invitation Video

The only thing left to do at this time is to fill out the application form. So take it out of your folder and with the pen provided begin at section 3 with your name and address.

There are Knights throughout the room to help you with your application. (Make sure your Brothers have their membership cards and are prepared to be the proposer for the prospect.)

Announce admission degree date, place and time.

- Hold on meeting night
- Invite families
- During the Exemplification
 - Show a movie to wives and children
 - The Father McGivney Story
 - The Greatest Miracle
 - Provide light snacks and refreshments
- THE LESSON IN CHARITY!



THE PARTICIPATION

- Following the degree, bring in the families to this special, "new member welcoming meeting."
- Blessing and Welcome by Father
- Invite the new members to consider the talents they bring, what inspires them, and how they can contribute to the parish mission
- Brief overview of council programs by the leaders of each
- Close with prayer and social time
