ROLL CALL AND SCAN INSTRUCTIONS

I ask the State Secretary to come forward for the purpose of Roll Call of the State Officers, todays attendance report and to provide brief instruction about the Badge Scanning Process, for those who were not with us yesterday afternoon.

For those who were not here yesterday... Here is a brief instruction. We are using the bar code scan technology. The bar code tracking will be used for daily attendance and your per-diem. It will also be used for identifying our voting strength, when needed.

Every voting delegate and non-voting Knight in attendance that is expecting to receive per-diem for your attendance, must be scanned in and out of the Meeting Chambers every single day.... sometimes twice a day maybe required to assure accurate voting strength.

Only one door will be used for scanning <u>IN and OUT</u>. Do not enter or exit any other door unless instructed to do so. The guards will be enforcing this rule.

When being scanned please have your bar-code badge in the lanyard sleeve, code bar out front ready to be scanned. The scanning guard will tell you if the scan was accepted and approved before entering the chambers.

Guests and Members of the Clergy do not have to be scanned.

2. The candidates will be asked to stand and identify themselves to the delegates.

3. The delegates will vote, and the ballots will be collected by the DD and presented to the Teller Committee for counting.

4. The Teller Committee will inform the State Deputy of the ballot count.

5. If no candidate receives a simple majority, the count will be announced and the candidate with the lowest number of votes will be asked to voluntarily withdraw his name from the ballot.

6. If the candidate declines to remove his name from the ballot, the vote will continue with his name on the ballot.

7. The Warden's Committee will distribute the second ballot.

8. The delegates will vote, and the ballots will be collected and given to the Teller Committee for counting.

9. The Teller Committee will inform the State Deputy of the ballot count.

10. If no candidate receives a simple majority, the above procedures will be employed until a candidate receives a simple majority.

11. Once a candidate receives a simple majority, the State Deputy will announce the winner and the state officer elect.
