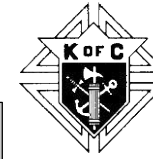

**IMPORTANT! - - - READ CAREFULLY THE RULES AND INFORMATION GIVEN BELOW.**

UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS MORAL SUPPORT SANCTION provides high score protection for those who have established membership in the Congress. USBC membership IS NOT required for this tournament. Non-USBC members wishing to secure high score protection may do so by paying \$21.00 per bowler with their entry.

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:** Member of Knights of Columbus council in Missouri in good standing; and immediate family members consisting of wives, parents, grandparents, children (including step-children), and in-laws (father, mother, brother, sister) of members.

**PRIZE AND ENTRY FEE:** The charge is \$17.00 per man per event, divided as follows: Prize Fee \$6.00, Bowling Fee \$6.00, Tournament Expense \$5.00. **PRIZE FEE WILL BE RETURNED 100% IN PRIZES.** Prize ratio according to USBC Rule No. 308 or better.

**ALL EVENTS:** Entry in All Events is optional with each individual bowler and will be on the handicap basis and the cost will be \$2.00 per person divided as follows: Prize Fee \$1.75, Tournament Expense .25¢.

**ENTERING AVERAGE:**

1. The Previous Season's highest USBC winter league average based on 21 games must be used.
  - a. At time of tournament, if current season average is 10 pins higher or lower than the previous year's average (based on 21 games minimum as of February 1, 2022), that average can be used (provide league sheet documenting average with entry or at check-in)
  - b. If currently bowling in non-USBC sanctioned league, submit those averages with a league sheet documenting your average
2. A bowler with no 2019-2020 USBC winter season average (21 games minimum), will use his highest current winter league average, based on a minimum of 21 games, as of February 1, 2022 (provide league sheet documenting average with entry or at check-in)
3. A bowler without a current or previous season USBC average SHALL ENTER AT HIS LAST SEASON BOWLED AVERAGE
  - a. Minimum average 150 (unless average was below 150), maximum average 170, and is at the discretion of tournament director
4. **If none of the above apply**, a bowler with K of C Tournament experience will be assigned an accumulative K of C Tournament average based on a minimum of 15 games bowled in previous tournaments.
  - a. Minimum average will be 125, Maximum average will be 170.
5. All other bowlers with minimal KofC tournament (less than 15 games) or no league experience shall be entered at 125.
  - a. Continues until 15 games accumulated in KofC Tournament (tournament average then overrules)
  - b. Tournament Director holds the option to bump this average to 150 if above average skill has been shown in prior tournaments
6. All averages submitted are verified by the tournament secretary against the USBC published averages at [www.bowl.com](http://www.bowl.com), and based on findings averages may be adjusted as appropriate, unless a non-sanctioned average is given and stated as such on the entry
7. Each bowler is responsible for entering his own correct average on the entry sheet, no matter by whom it was submitted. Refer to USBC Rule 319A-3.
8. The Annual Tournament of the Missouri Knights of Columbus Bowling Association shall be conducted on a Handicap Basis. Each entrant shall receive a handicap of seventy-five percent (75%) of the difference between his previous season's highest League Average and two hundred twenty (220) pins for each game entered.

**MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** Multiple participation WILL BE ALLOWED IN ALL 3 EVENTS. No more than three (3) players on the same team can place more than once in the Prize List for position standings. May cash only once in the Doubles with Same Partner. May cash only once in the Singles, with Highest Place to be paid. The best scores by the individuals will be used for All Events.

**BOWLING LINE UP:** Be sure to list the names in the order you wish them to appear on the official score sheet. SCORE SHEETS WILL BE PREPARED AND HANDICAPPED IN ADVANCE ACCORDING TO POSITIONS AS LISTED ON ENTRY FORM.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** When necessary substitutions may be made by notifying the tournament secretary at least 30 minutes before the time scheduled to bowl. Substitute bowlers are not eligible for All Events unless the original bowler had submitted for it with their entry

**SPECIAL RULES:**

1. Any person bowling on a team who is NOT a member of the Knights of Columbus or a properly qualified family member, he and the other members of that team may be barred from future tournaments
2. "Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes including natural disasters, strikes, lockouts, medical epidemic / pandemic, or other reasons beyond the control of Missouri State Council Knights of Columbus, shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination."
3. Should the event need to be cancelled prior to the scheduled date, a partial refund will be offered, or a credit offered towards the next tournament
4. You will bowl three (3) games in each event on a pair of lanes assigned by the tournament secretary.
  - a. Singles and doubles will be bowled on the same pair
  - b. Doubles will begin immediately after singles has been completed
  - c. Doubles only entrants may be placed on different lanes, if available
5. Bowlers who participate in this tournament must be dressed in a neat and presentable manner, and the manner of dress is to be determined by the tournament committee
6. Plaques will be awarded to the winners of each event as follows: singles, doubles, team (all members), All Events, high scratch game, high scratch series. If multiple awards are won by an individual, those awards may be combined.
7. USBC Rule No. 319E is Waived.
8. **NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEE FOR CANCELLATIONS MADE AFTER MARCH 8, 2021.**
9. BOWLERS CAN BE FROM DIFFERENT COUNCILS. However, they must be a member in good standing of the Knights of Columbus and follow all the published tournament eligibility requirements
10. Entry Deadline may be extended at the discretion of, and arrangements made with, the Association Secretary.
11. Teams may be mixed with members and ladies, same with doubles entries. All scoring rules are the same for ladies and men.
