All members of the Knights of Columbus participating agree to comply with the rules of the United States Bowling Congress And the Tournament Rules of the Wisconsin Knights of Columbus Bowling Committee.

2026 REGULATIONS

- 1 Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between 235 and the actual average. Highest average from the USBC 2024-25 season; if none for the last year, use average from 2 years ago. If no USBC book average for the past 2 years, bowler will use his KC Tournament average going back up to 3 years.
- 2 Individual averages must be based on a league average with a minimum of 21 games. If there is no average for the (2) previous seasons and a current average has been established for (21) or more games, as of the entry date, use the current average. If the highest current average for (21) games or more as of entry date is (15) pins or more than the average above, current average must be used (per Wisconsin State Bowling Committee). We do not require the reporting of previous prize winnings. If you bowl in a league, please send in league average sheets with entry form.
- 3 It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify scores. If submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in more handicap, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average.
- 4 An entrant is obligated to submit himself for re-rating, if within the past 12 months, he has accumulated an average in (21) or more games of tournament play, which exceeds the average to be used by (15) or more pins.
- 5 If a person does not have an average established above, he will be given an average for handicap purposes, based on current tournament games bowled in this Wisconsin K of C Tournament. These averages will be kept on file with the State of Wisconsin K of C Bowling Tournament Committee.
- 6 There is no maximum handicap per bowler per game.
- 7 The Host council bowlers may re-enter on non-hosting teams as many times as needed to ensure full lineups. A host council bowler may compete more than once in the Team or Doubles events, providing he is substituting for an original entrant in these events. Not more than (3) bowlers on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. The all Events score will count for the host council bowler when bowling with his council.
- 8 Substitutes not to exceed (2) are allowed in the Team event. In the Doubles event, one scheduled person must bowl. In the Singles event, the absent bowler will receive no score.
- 9 Full Legal Name should be printed plainly to avoid error in schedule, score books, etc...
- 10 Early Bird entries close January 15, 2026, however all entries postmarked the first Post Office business day after entry closing date will be accepted. No record of entries until money is received.
- 11 After any entry fee has been received and filed, the entry fee will not be refunded.
- 12 Bowlers are asked to be ready to bowl when it is their turn. This will ensure that your fellow bowlers will be able to begin their scheduled shifts on time.
- 13 All bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled shift to bowl.
- 14 USBC moral support certified provides high score recognition of USBC members participating while permitting non-USBC
 - members to compete in certified competition. Eligible non-USBC members desiring the USBC recognition awards may purchase an associate membership card prior to bowling. Only entrants who have established USBC membership prior to participation shall be qualified for USBC High Score Recognition.
- 15 Entry fee is \$35.00 per Handicap Event, which includes bowling, prize money and tournament expenses. (There is a \$5.00 early bird discount, per persons, per handicap event if entry is postmarked by January 15, 2026)
 - **** An additional \$6.00 per event for SCRATCH EVENTS IS AVAILABLE/OPTIONAL ****
- 16 Any bowlers participating in the "Optional Scratch Events", MUST bowl in the Handicap Events to be eligible.
- 17 Prizes shall be awarded in both the Handicap and Scratch divisions of the Tournament
- 18 ***Team Event: A minimum of Two (2) Knights of Columbus members or Lady Knights in good standing must be included on each Team Entry submission. The other Team entrants may be an invited Guest (see definition).
 - ***Doubles Event: Invited Guest (see definition) shall be eligible to enter the Doubles Event with a KC member or Lady Knight for this event
 - ***Singles Event: Invited Guest (see definition) shall be eligible to enter the Singles Event.
 - ***All Events: Invited Guest (see definition) shall be eligible in the All Events Category for prizes.
 - ***Definition of invited Guest: Invited Guest is a Person 18 years of age. For Catholic Male Guests we encourage the Council bringing in the bowler to have them informed what the Knights of Columbus stands for.
 - ***Definition of Lady Knight: Spouse or Significant other of Knight in good standing
- 19 CURRENT KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS TRAVEL CARD MUST BE PRESENTED WHEN CHECKING IN. INVITED GUEST MUST HAVE VALID **DRIVERS LICENSE OR VALID ID.**
