Gentlemen some of these losses are preventable by having a good Retention Team. It is your responsibility tKeep your Membership Teams geared up and ready to recruit. Strong Team Members are the key to success. District Deputies and Grand Knights must train their Team Members so that they have every tool available to meet their recruiting objective. Councils must be planning recruiting events well in advance and get everyone energized. PLAN, PLAN, PLAN!

Based on a percentage glide path your membership goal accomplishment should be the following: by the end of March 75%, April 83%, May 91% and Jun 100%. Maintain this glide path as your minimum goal and recruit so that you are always ahead of the glide path because catching up is a struggle.
