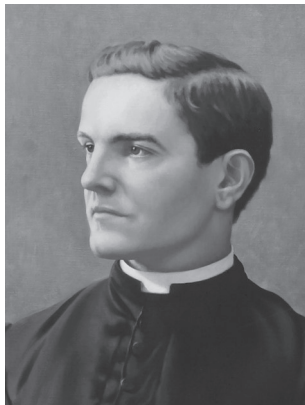
Brother Knights, Ladies and Guests;
