The 113th Annual Colorado State Council Knights of Columbus State Convention is quickly approaching. The 2015 State Convention is scheduled to be held at the Keystone Resort & Conference Center. The dates for the convention are *THURSDAY - SUNDAY*, *April* 23rd - *April* 26TH, 2015.

Delegates to the convention <u>MUST REGISTER</u> with these <u>three</u> (3) places: (1) The hotel for a room reservation, (2) The State Secretary (Jim Caffrey) for credentials and (3) The convention-registration chairman (Jerry Sundee) for meals. **Registering** with the **State Secretary <u>DOES NOT</u>** mean we have allocated a meal for you. **Registering** with the **Convention Committee <u>DOES NOT</u>** mean you have **voting privileges** during the business meetings.

A **Registration Fee of \$15.00 per Knight or main registrant** will be assessed to help cover the cost of the convention bag, name tags and registration materials.

We are looking forward to another successful convention. We would hope that <u>ALL</u> our Brother Knights will make a concerted effort to attend some or all of the events. Included in this packet is valuable information that you will want to provide to all members of your councils and assemblies throughout the state. A *tentative* agenda of activities is included for your reference, but is subject to change as the convention date draws nearer.

Room Reservations

A Special Block of Rooms is established for the Colorado Knights of Columbus if made prior to Monday, March 23, 2015. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS!!! After March 23rd, "late reservation requests will be handled on a space available basis. The \$120.00 rate will be honored."

- 1. Individuals are responsible for making their own reservations. Please contact the main reservation number for Keystone Resort. **For online reservations, go to coloradokofc.org and click the link.** Our group code is **CC9CAL**. The group name and rates will appear as long as there is still availability in the block. Select the room type preferred and proceed to booking
- 2. Room types available at \$120/night plus tax: Keystone Lodge & Spa, Inn at Keystone, Conference Village Studio and Conference Village 1 bedroom.
- 3. **The phone number for the hotel is 1-800-258-0437.** Be sure to identify yourself as a Knights of Columbus Convention attendee. Room rates will be \$120.00 plus tax.

Hospitality Rooms

All hospitality room reservations are made directly with the Convention Chairman, Paul Patricca. Keystone Resorts will not accept hospitality room reservations directly! A Hospitality Room Reservation Form is included in this packet to be used by councils, assemblies, districts, or individuals requesting a Hospitality Room. There is a minimum \$120/per night flat fee depending on room selection. Hospitality Rooms are LIMITED. Rooms will be assigned on a FIRST COME BASIS. You are strongly encouraged to send in your form early.

The Opening Night Dinner will focus upon Clergy Appreciation. We are encouraging all councils to invite their clergy to join us at the Opening Mass conducted on Thursday evening, the 23rd, followed by the appreciation event. The cost is \$35.00 per person for this activity.

Banquet

The hotel can accommodate up to 1000 people. All attendees will be assigned seating at a table in one room. There will be no overflow seating. Table assignments will be based on your district's increased membership percentage as of March 31, 2015. There is no unassigned seating. Attendance commitments **RECEIVED BY March 31, 2015** are **ASSURED** seating with **THEIR DISTRICT**. **ALL** others will be seated on a **FIRST COME-FIRST SERVED** basis.

PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO FRIDAY BANQUET TICKETS SOLD AT THE CONVENTION. RESERVATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY FRIDAY APRIL 10.
