This will allow for fast delivery and will save the State Council money on mailings regarding state meetings, such as the 2018 State Convention, or any special announcements.



They also provide opportunities to form friendships and serve Christ by aiding our Churches, communities, and each other.

One goal for the Missouri State Ladies Auxiliaries Chairpersons is to start new Auxiliaries. When a new Council or Assembly is formed this can be a great opportunity to start an Auxiliary. These meetings are the time when Presidents and their board members have a chance to talk with other Auxiliaries in their areas. This is also an opportunity for them to learn, share and receive information and guidelines concerning State programs and forms.

District Deputies, Grand Knights, and Faithful Navigators, please remember to include the Ladies in your semi-annual District Deputy meetings. The Ladies depend on you to bring information back from State meetings that are not distributed at the State Convention, such as the State Directory, Program Manuals, awards, certificates and any new State programs or initiatives. Please also reach out to the Ladies Auxiliaries to see if you can assist with any functions or if they can help you. Do not forget they are great so-cial planners and a recruitment tool for your Councils and Assemblies.

Guidelines for Starting an Auxiliary

- Contact your Missouri State Council Ladies Auxiliary Chairpersons. They will help you with an exploratory
 meeting between District Deputy, Grand Knight of the Council and ladies interested in starting a Ladies Auxiliary. Discussion at the meeting will be information to acquaint the ladies with the service programs of the local
 Parish Council, the Missouri State Council programs, and the structure for the Auxiliary. The Council membership roster can be used so that a list of prospective members can be created for contacting future members.
- Following the exploratory meeting, invites and personal contact should be directed to those considered eligible to attend a formational meeting. At this meeting, the objectives of the Ladies Auxiliary will be presented and the Knights of Columbus State Auxiliary By-Laws reviewed. Discussions for the start-up can include election of officers, meeting dates/times, yearly dues and goals of your Auxiliary.
- 3. All Knights of Columbus Councils wishing to start a Ladies Auxiliary and further wants to be affiliated with the Knights of Columbus Missouri State Council must present an application for Charter to the Missouri State Council Ladies Auxiliary Chairpersons. The charter application must be presented with a legible list of Charter members. Upon approval by the State Deputy, the Auxiliary will be issued a Charter.
- 4. Ladies considered for membership shall be one of the following: 1) A wife of a Knight in good standing; 2) A mother of Knight in good standing; 3) A daughter (18 years or older) of a Knight in good standing or 4) A member of a Religious Order, in good standing with their Order. Applications for membership must be submitted to the affiliate Council, Knights of Columbus Financial Secretary for approval.
- 5. Charter members are those whose names have been submitted with the charter application and who have made a commitment by paying their entrance fee.
- 6. Immediately upon the election of officers, the Presidents name, address and phone number will be submitted to the State Ladies Auxiliary Chairpersons with the Charter application.
- 7. The Auxiliary will need to have a minimum of **ten (10)** ladies signed up as Auxiliary members before submitting the Charter application for approval.

OPERATIONS

- To the Officers, learn the interests and abilities of all your members. Keep in mind their time and talents to benefit the Auxiliaries goals. Be open to all members when appointing chairpersons on program activities. Consider a mentor to coach the new members with Knights of Columbus Supreme and State programs. When filling committee appointments, consider co-chairpersons to work in new ideas with the established programs.
- 2. Auxiliary meetings can be held at your parish hall, with approval from parish staff. Meetings should be organized, run orderly, held to a time limit, have State Chairmen visit and discuss their program and promote social time. Maintain the meeting start time for each meeting and follow through in a business-like manner. Meeting agenda outlines are listed on the last page of the State Ladies Auxiliary By-Laws. ROBERTS RULES OF OR-DER are the preferred guidelines that need to be followed when conducting the meeting.
- 3. Installation of Auxiliary officers can be an open affair for family members to attend. You may want to schedule the installation of officers in conjunction with the Knights of Columbus Officers that is conducted by the local District Deputy.
- 4. Give members a reason to belong. This can be emphasized through the Knights of Columbus programs in Church, Charity, Youth and Community activities.
- 5. Maintain a Christian attitude in all your undertakings as an Auxiliary for the Missouri Knights of Columbus.
- 6. Keep our Worthy State Deputy, Joe Rosenthal's motto in mind this fraternal year: "Saving Lives, Changing Lives".
