### Qualifications

A candidate must be a Third Degree member of the Knights of Columbus in good standing.

### Exemplification Fee (Cost to Join)

The Exemplification fee is \$70.00 per candidate, payable to the District Master. This fee covers a Fourth Degree pin, a social baldric, and Supreme Council assessment.

#### **Dress for Exemplification**

The official dress for candidates for the Fourth Degree Exemplification is a black or dark (blue or gray) business suit with black shoes, plain white dress shirt and necktie. Members on active duty military are authorized to wear their dress uniform. Full time police and firefighting officers are authorized to wear their dress uniform.

#### **Color Corps Uniform**

Candidates and Fourth Degree members are not required to purchase the Color Corp Uniform. The Uniform consists of an Official Navy Blue Blazer with Fourth Degree Emblem Blazer Crest, Official Fourth Degree Gray trousers, Official Fourth Degree Necktie, Official Fourth Degree Black Beret with Fourth Degree metal badge over appropriate colored patch, Plain White Dress Shirt - button cuff (no French cuffs - no button down collar shirts) and Black socks with Black Shoes. These are only required of those members participating in the Color Corps. These items can be purchased in the future if you want to join the Color Corps. We encourage candidates to join the Color Corps.
