**ELIGIBILITY:** Each contestant must have a completely filled out orange Travel Card and sign, with their parent/guardian, a release/waiver form at registration. Contestants must be 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students and a winner or alternate at a 2014-15 Diocesan Competition.

**AWARDS:** Trophy – 1<sup>st</sup> place; medals and certificates for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> places.  
Awards will be presented in the cafeteria as soon as the results are finalized!

NOTE: Contestants will wait in the cafeteria after registration with their parent(s)/families until they are brought to their contest rooms. Parent(s)/families are to remain there during the competition. When finished, students will be dismissed back to the cafeteria until the awards program. A snack bar will be operating for lunch and refreshments!

The contest format will be a multiple choice instrument similar to that used at Council and Diocesan (Regional) levels.

\*\*Note: Contestants may only compete in 1 contest – Math, Spelling or Free Throw!
