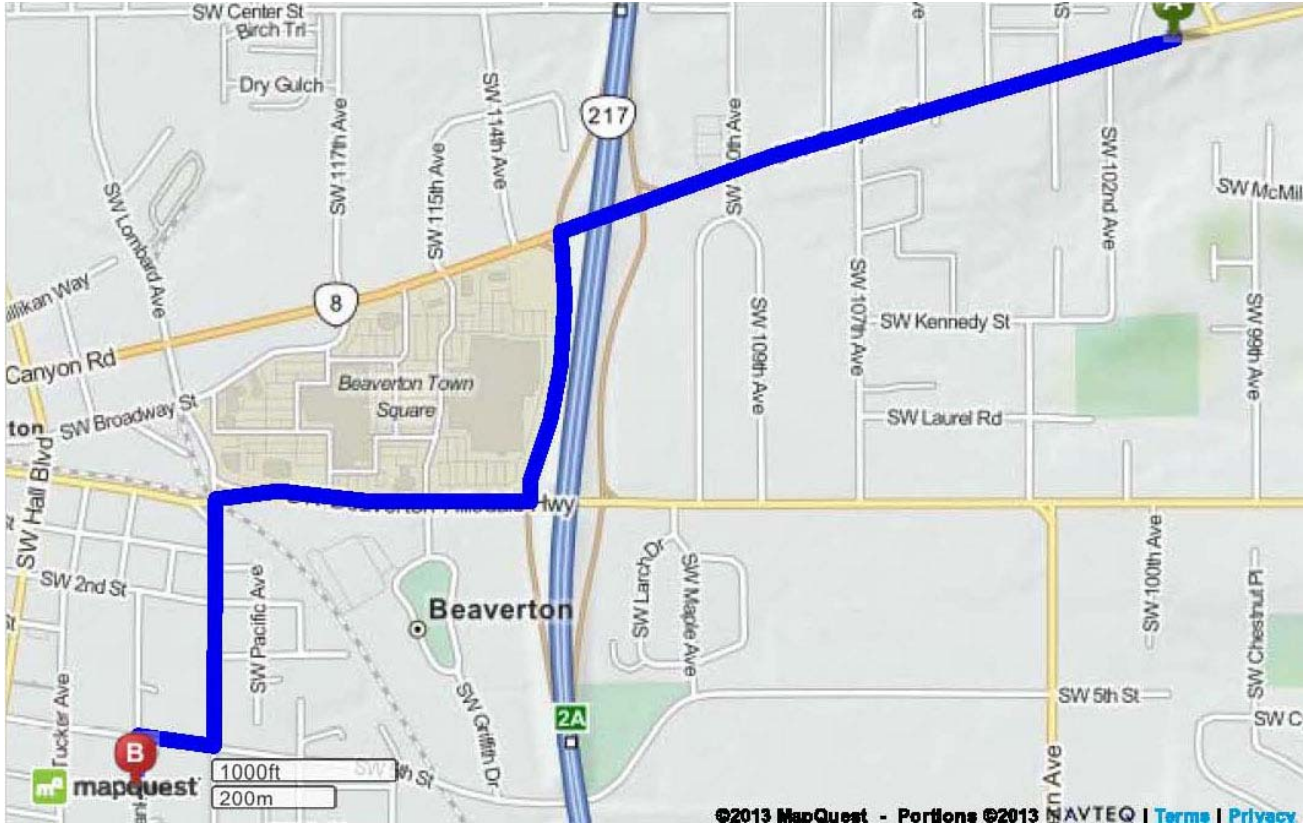

Japanese Garden & Washington Square Mall

The 5.5-acre at the **Japanese Garden** is composed of five distinct garden styles. When we enter a Japanese garden, the desired effect is to realize a sense of peace, harmony, and tranquility and to experience the feeling of being a part of nature. In a deep sense, the Japanese garden is a living reflection of the long history and traditional culture of Japan. Influenced by Shinto, Buddhist, and Taoist philosophies, there is always "something more" in these compositions of stone, water, and plants than meets the eye. Three of the essential elements used to create a Japanese garden are **stone**, the "bones" of the landscape; **water**, the life-giving force; and **plants**, the tapestry of the four seasons.

Father Taaffe Homes

In the early nineteen seventies when discussion about legalizing abortion became an issue, Father Taaffe became concerned that if abortion became legal, the choice to give birth for single teenage mothers would become difficult, if not impossible. Having counseled pregnant teens, he was troubled, there would be pressure for them to have abortions because it was "less complicated" for everyone involved. He believed that people needed to be reminded about the "sanctity of life". So, he enlisted the help of Betty Marsh, then the Salem City Recorder, and began speaking on the subject to everyone who would listen.
