

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Wisconsin Knights of Columbus Punt, Pass and Kick (PP&K) Competition is open to all grade and junior high (middle) school boys and girls, ages 8 through 12 in the State of Wisconsin. Each entrant must be prepared to furnish legal proof of his or her age. Seven-year-olds that will reach their eighth birthday by August 31 of the present contest year may compete. A twelve-year-old boy or girl, who becomes thirteen on or before August 31 of the present contest year, will not be eligible.
- 2. There is no cost, nor is a purchase required of any boy or girl, parent or sponsor, to enter or compete.
- 3. Contestants must register on official entry forms with the local council. Each entrant's parent or legal guardian must countersign the official entry form.
- 4. Each contestant may enter only once. Anyone who participates in more than one local competition will be disqualified.
- 5. Contestants ages 8 through 11 will use a junior-size football for the competition; contestants age 12 will compete with a regulation size football.
- 6. Contestants are not allowed to use a resin or any "stick-um" type substance for better grip. Gloves are also not allowed!
- 7. <u>Football or soccer cleats are allowed, recommended (permitted and encouraged) at ALL levels of competition</u>. Sneakers (Tennis Shoes) may also be worn to compete. <u>Boots or street shoos of any type are NOT to be permitted at any level of competition</u>.
- 8. Each boy or girl will compete in three categories: punting, passing and kicking (using a kicking tee). The contestant may do the 3 categories in whatever order they wish. There will be 3 attempts for each category with the first being a practice. Judges will score one point for each foot that the ball travels in the air, minus one point for each foot the ball lands to the right or left of the center tape. When competing, a reasonable distance for the three or four step approach will be allowed. If a contestant oversteps the starting or "baseline," the amount of such overstep will be subtracted from his distance and accuracy for the event exception: place kicking, when the contestant is allowed to step over the baseline as is normal in a "kickoff." Measurements will be calculated and recorded to the lesser half foot (a kick of 30 feet-3 inches will be scored as 30 points; a measurement of 30 feet-9 inches will be scored as 30.5 points. The longest of the 2 scored attempts in each category will be added together to create the final score. Tees should be 1" tees if at all possible. The 1" tee is used at State contest!
- 9. No cash prizes. Medals, certificates, plaques or trophies may be awarded. Local level competition will be financed entirely by the local council.

Council winners will advance to the Diocesan level. Diocesan competition will have awards furnished by the Wisconsin State Council. State winners will receive awards from the Wisconsin State Council.

10. Awards: Council: Discretion of each council

Diocesan: First, Second & Third State: First, Second & Third

- 11. The judges have general regulation and control of competition and their decisions will be final. The judges will be responsible for putting the ball in play and they have the final authority over the ball's position. In case of ties, tie-breaking rounds will be held to determine the winner, but the original score of the winner (the one which necessitated the tie-breaker) will be recorded as the winner's official score.

- 13. <u>Council first place winners</u> advance to Diocesan competition. <u>Diocesan first and second place winners</u> advance to State competition.
- 14. At the Diocesan and State Competition, each contestant will make two attempts for each category. The best score for each category will be used in calculating their final score. In case of ties, the unused scores will be used to break the tie.
- 15. Timeline: Council Contests: August 1-September 29

Results to Diocesan program Coordinators by October 1

Diocesan Contests: October 5-20

Results to State Youth Athletics Coordinator by October 22 State Contest: October 26, 2019 (Regis High School, Eau Claire)

16. Travel Cards – <u>All</u> winners advancing to the Diocesan level of competition must receive a <u>green</u> travel card from their Council Contest Coordinator. Alternates should also receive one if they are going to compete. They <u>must</u> have these in their possession to register and compete at that level! <u>All</u> travel cards <u>must</u> be <u>completely</u>, accurately and <u>legibly</u> filled out by the Contest Coordinator, competitor, and parents before leaving the council competition site. <u>Do not</u> expect the kids, parents to fill them out themselves. <u>Program Chair/phone should be the person who ran the contest they've just competed in.</u>
Be sure to circle all the proper information at the bottom of the card.

For Diocesan winners, the same instructions apply except that 1^{st} and 2^{nd} place winners advance. This should be an <u>orange</u> card that says "State only" at the bottom under "Competition Level." Diocesan Program Coordinators and parents/athlete should fill it out.

- 17. An athlete may compete in both the Punt, Pass and Kick and Soccer competitions at the council level. However, He/she may only compete in 1 contest at the Diocesan and State levels since they are run simultaneously at the State level. The only exception is if Diocesan contests are run at different sites/times/dates. An alternate can then be chosen to take his/her place.
- 18. Council Report forms must be sent to the Diocesan Program Coordinator, District Deputy and the State Forms address. Diocesan Report forms must be sent to the State Youth Athletics Coordinator, State Program Director and State Forms address.








B: Line up Marking Rope
