Knights can then pick them up from the parish office at your convenience and we'll purchase the cards with the money donated. The gift cards should be pre-paid MasterCard or Visa cards, national brand stores or gas cards, or Amazon cards.

District Deputies will personally be transporting the items collected from area Parishes to our Winter District Deputy meeting December 3-5 to be distributed to the Bishops of Wisconsin for our seminarians and novices throughout the 5 Dioceses in Wisconsin.
