A Message from the Supreme Knight

A SURE PATH FOR RENEWAL

THE CHALLENGE OF REFORM AND PRESERVING UNITY WITHIN THE CHURCH CALLS FOR NATURAL AND SUPERNATURAL VIRTUE

EARLIER THIS YEAR, I attended the consecration of a beautifully restored church. As the Blessed Sacrament was placed in the new tabernacle, I thought of the Ark of the Covenant, which was the place of God's presence among his people, beginning in the time of Moses. Now, in the New Covenant, the Lord's true presence is a reality wherever Mass is celebrated and wherever the Eucharist is reserved.

As Catholics, we may take this reality for granted today, but the initial reaction to Jesus' discourse on the bread of life was one of disbelief — the Jews saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" and his disciples saying, "This is a hard saying, who can listen to it?" Most of his disciples actually left, and Jesus then turned to the Apostles: "Will you also go away?" As we know, Peter answered, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life" (Jn 6:68).

Jesus' question remains painfully real in light of the devastating scandals that have recently rocked the Church and the declining church attendance among Catholics. And if Jesus' question has new relevance, so does Peter's answer. If we were to turn away from the presence of the Lord, where would we go?

There is a growing trend, especially among young people, to say that we can be "spiritual" while also rejecting organized religion. Pope Benedict XVI addressed this issue in his encyclical *Spe Salvi* (Saved in Hope) when he asked, "Is Christian hope individualistic?" He answered that "salvation has always been considered a 'social' reality," adding that we are called "to a lived union with a 'people,' and for each individual it can only be attained with this 'we'" (14).

We see this social reality, this unity within the Church, most beautifully in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the hundreds of thousands of tabernacles throughout the world. And this call to communion is especially important for us as Knights of Columbus, committed this year in a special way to the principle of unity.

As we pray for and seek renewal in our Church today, I am reminded what the 18th-century British statesman Edmund Burke said about institutions in need of reform. He argued that the virtue of prudence is necessary to find the right combination of "conservation and correction."

We should keep in mind Burke’s recommendation of prudence. In the foreseeable future, however, the most important of the cardinal virtues may not be prudence but fortitude, which the Catechism of the Catholic Church defines as “the moral virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good” (1808).

And as St. Thomas Aquinas taught, fortitude is dependent upon yet another virtue: justice — certainly today, justice for the victims of sexual abuse and their families as well as justice for the People of God.

Indeed, all four of the cardinal virtues — prudence, justice, fortitude and temperance — will be necessary to achieve “correction” while preserving the unity of the Church.

In *Spe Salvi*, Pope Benedict further reminded us: “God is the foundation of hope. ... His love alone gives us the possibility of soberly persevering day by day, without ceasing to be spurred on by hope” (31).

In the days ahead, therefore, let us rededicate ourselves to the practice of the moral virtues and pray for an increase in faith, hope and charity. In this way, we will continue to move forward, meeting whatever challenges may arise.

The Lord remains in the midst of his people, and he will never abandon us. He calls us to unity. He calls us to virtue. And in him, we will find a sure path for renewal.

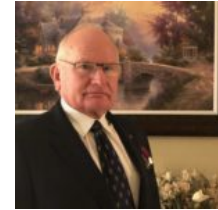

The cause for the canonization of Father Michael J. McGivney was opened by the Archdiocese of Hartford on December 10, 1997. Simultaneously, the Father McGivney Guild was established to gather and disseminate information on the life and legacy of this parish priest and founder of the Knights of Columbus. Fr. Gabriel O'Donnell, OP is the postulator of McGivney's cause as well as director of the Guild.

On March 15, 2008, Pope Benedict XVI approved a decree recognizing the heroic virtue of Father Michael J. McGivney. The pope's declaration significantly advanced his process towards sainthood and gives Fr. McGivney the distinctive title of "Venerable Servant of God." Soon to be Blessed Father Michael McGivney.

To quote Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, "All of us who are members of the knights of Columbus are profoundly grateful for this recognition of the holiness of our founder. The strength of the Knights of Columbus today is a testament to his timeless vision, his holiness and his ideals."

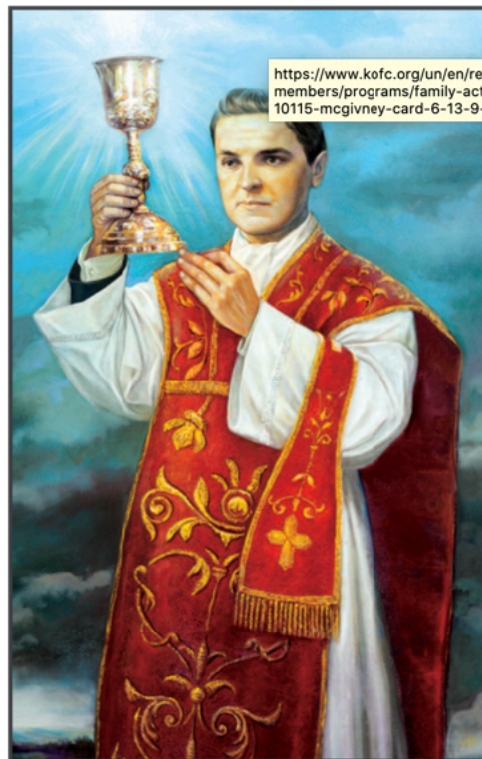
Grand Knights are asked to become aware of those Knights in their Councils that are not currently Guild members and be prepared, with an application, to encourage them to become members. It is

July saw the Order's first-ever Virtual Field Agent Sales Conference, which focused largely on new-member recruitment. Our Agents look forward to sharing many conference takeaways with your Councils in greater detail, but here are a few of the highlights:

- We saw a new video testimony from General Agent Dan Schachle, whose son Mikey's healing was the miracle approved for Fr. McGivney's beatification. Our Founder is still protecting Catholic families!
- In April, Standard & Poor's gave the Knights a 1st-place ranking for financial strength and stability among North American life insurers. Along with 48 consecutive years of A.M. Best's Superior rating, this evidences the fact that a company can remain a top contender in the financial world while remaining true to its Catholic values.

The past few months have proven that this system will produce greater collaboration between Agents and their Councils and will also better promote our top-notch fraternal insurance organization.

So, Brothers, I encourage you to appoint one officer—perhaps the Membership Director, as this is a natural recruiting opportunity—to take the lead on planning these events with your Field Agent. I am confident that every Council can earn a Star this year!

Write out what Father could say at the beginning; after the homily and at the end of Mass. [That way ANY Priest could HELP in recruitment.] Grand Knights, you could even offer the Pastor/priest an incentive for every man who signs up. Be creative! 25 October would be **GREAT!** 2 great commandments: Be a knight to love God and to truly do for our neighbor. Gentlemen, you’ve got it made: convince your Pastor to have the membership drive on 24/25 October. Organize the council **TO BE PRESENT.** Easy to write up the material for Masses utilizing the readings. Be present and show the men of God how they can love God and their Neighbor **BETTER** by being a Knight of Columbus!!!!

I believe the above is plenty for September. I would urge you to **MAKE MEMBERSHIP HAPPEN** by emphasizing “Leave No Neighbor Behind”. That’s our program. That’s a goal of a **TRUE KNIGHT OF COLUMBUS!**

Implementing your Retention Strategy

Brother Knights,

At this point and time, your council should have implemented its Retention strategy. The Grand Knight should have appointed a Retention Chairman and his other Service Program Personnel on Form 365 and submitted it to Member Management by 1 August 2020.

Many of you Knights have heard the same information being put out, time after time. Yet, we still seem to have Knights that lose interest. Member retention begins as soon as they complete their formation degree Charity, Unity and Fraternity. From the start, new members should be encouraged to be active and to participate in its virtual meetings, socials, and weekly rosaries. Inspire the new member, mentor him in becoming committee chair person to assist in the success of its council goals. Inform him and promote the Shining Armor Award.

To qualify for the “Shining Armor Award” new Knights must during their first year of membership:

- Be involved in at least three council service programs
- Attend at least three council business meetings
- Receive their Second and Third degrees (Completed with new Formation Degree)
- Meet with their council’s insurance representative
- Recruit at least one new member

Always make it a point to contact the new member. Let him know all the information regarding the meeting whether it’s going in person or to a virtual meeting. If the new member becomes inactive in council activities, try to find out why. Call and ask to visit with him. Explain your concern about his absence and offer support or assistance.

If the Knight becomes in danger of being suspended, his proposer should work with the retention committee to find out the reasons for his lapsed interest and to work to conserve his membership. It is our responsibility to maintain a strong, friendly and fraternal atmosphere among Knights and their families, of your councils.

WPSD Sir Knight David M. Ryan, PSD, FDD, PFN and PGK 2010-2012

Raised on a farm in western Kansas, he was the next to the youngest of 11 children, five brothers and five sisters. On 5 December 1964, he joined Knights of Columbus council 2647 in Colby, Kansas taking all three degrees. He was elected to the position of inside guard in May 1965 but resigned in May 1966 to join the United States Air Force.

SK David served in the U.S. Air Force for the next 26 years serving in the Vietnam theater from June 1967 to January 1969 and again from February 1972 to August 1973 as a weapons mechanic certified to load munitions on F-4, F-100, F105, F-111, OV-10, A1E and B52 aircraft. His last overseas assignment was in Pakistan from May 1988 until June 1990 as the operations coordinator for the Defense Intelligence Agency, in the Defense Attaché Office U.S. Embassy in Islamabad. David retired on 1 June 1992 from Nellis Air Force Base as the Maintenance Superintendent of the 57th Equipment Maintenance Squadron.

Military decorations include the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Air Force Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Air Force Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, Vietnam Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with one Oak Leaf Cluster, Vietnam Campaign Medal, and Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross with Palm.

As a member of the Knights of Columbus Sir Knight David M. Ryan held office in both the council and assembly and served as Grand Knight of council 10442 and Faithful Navigator of Assembly 611 in Las Vegas. He joined the first-degree team for council 5693 as the DGK in 1981. He is certified and remain active in all four degrees. From 1996 - 1998 served as the District Warden for District 9 in Nevada. From 2002 - 2004, served as the State Retention Chairman and in June 2004 David was asked to assume the duties as District Deputy for District 9. My district exceeded our membership and insurance quotes by 1 December that year and he was recognized as the District Deputy of the year for 2004-2005 and 2006-2007 fraternal years. As District Deputy, he instituted council 14144 at Christ the King parish and started the round table at the Newman Center at the University Nevada Las Vegas, now council 15061. In May 2007, SK David was elected as the State Warden, May 2008 to the position of State Advocate and in 2010 as State Deputy. Nevada achieved Circle of Honor for the 2011-2012 fraternal year.

During the 2013 – 2014 fraternal year he served as the State Membership Director and the State again achieved Circle of Honor. SK David had to resign as the State Membership Director to assume my duties as the District Master.

As State Deputy, he introduced the ultrasound program into Nevada and placed two machines during his term as State Deputy. He continues to serve as the main contact for the ultrasound program in Nevada.

Nevada has placed six machines in the three centers in Nevada that meet the requirements of the program with the latest ultrasound machine being a mobile machine in at First Choice Pregnancy Services in Las Vegas.

Sir Knight Ryan was elected to the board of directors for First Choice Pregnancy Services in April 2012 and termed out per by-laws in 2019 after seven years on the board.

In 2014, He was appointed Master of the Nevada District. Since that appointment four new assemblies have been added and membership has grown from 23.6 percent to 27.4 percent of the members in the state. With the introduction of the Star Assembly Award in 2015-2016 fraternal year, Nevada had four Star Assemblies or 8% of the Star Assemblies in the Order's initial year.

On 1 September 2019 he was appointed as the Vice Supreme Master for the St Junipero Serra Province.

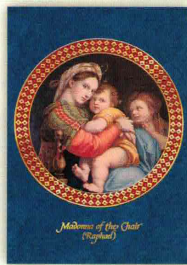

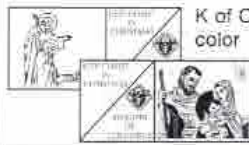

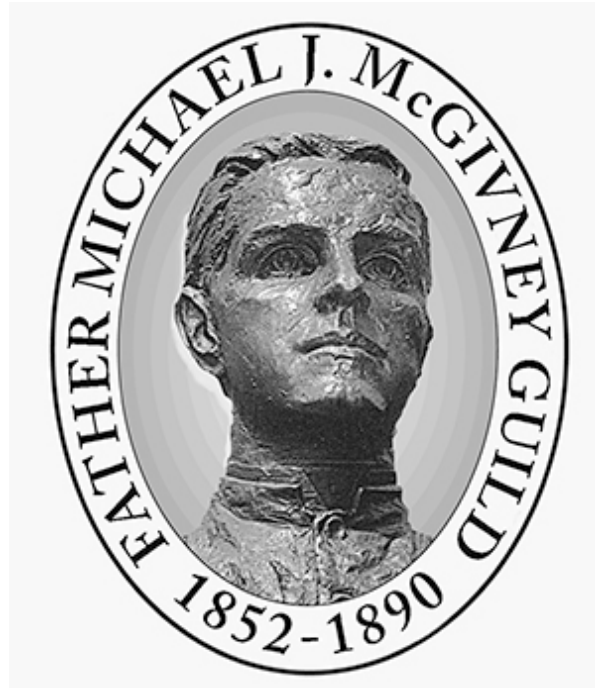
