Message from the State Deputy



Dear Brothers,

I hope your Christmas and New Year's be abundantly filled with God's Blessing and that you are ready for a very exciting and productive 2019. I have been reading a book that is over 75 years old by C.S. Lewis entitled "The Screwtape Letters" about a demon's letters to his nephew (also a demon) on how to win over the people assigned to them for the Devil. It is very timely and could have been written today. It points out the subtle ways that they influence people in thoughts, desires, lack of conviction and by getting them to waste their time in worthless pursuits on earth. I would highly recommend that in addition to the Bible you add this one book to your 2019 Christian reading list.

One of the devotional readings I had today was "An excellent method of preserving interior silence is to keep exterior silence. . . even in the world, each one of us can make his own solitude, a boundary beyond which nothing can force its way unperceived. It is not noise in itself that is the difficulty, but noise that is pointless; it is not every conversation, but useless conversations; not all kinds of occupation, but aimless occupations. In point of fact, everything that does not serve some good purpose is harmful. It is foolish, nay, more, it is a betrayal to devote to a useless objective power that can be given to what is essential. There are two ways of separating ourselves from almighty God, quite different from one another but both disastrous, although for different reasons: mortal sin and voluntary distractions—mortal sin, which objectively breaks off our union with God, and voluntary distractions, which subjectively interrupt or hinder our union from being as close as it ought to be. We should speak only when it is preferable not to keep silence. The Gospel does not say merely that we shall have to give an account of every evil word, but of every idle thought." — St. Alphonsus Liguori.

The point of recommending the book and sharing the devotional is to ask that our 2019 resolution be that this year we will start using all our time in pursuit of that which is pleasing to God, strengthens the Church, our Families and Order of the Knights of Columbus.



A Game Changer for Prospecting for Members

Brothers,

I've just come back from the Mid-Year Meeting of State Deputies in Houston, Texas. We discussed a lot of great ideas and best practices that have the potential to make a big impact here in our jurisdiction. One that I'm really excited about is a new prospecting system that we can use for all kinds of things: church drives, men's conferences, pancake breakfasts, spaghetti dinners, fish fries - really any event where we have potential members.

We'll talk more about it at the mid-year organizational meeting, but it's a really simple process. Supreme will build a custom Prospect Landing Page for your council that you can use on a phone, a tablet or a computer. You can ask potential members if they're interested in learning more about the Knights, and you can enter their information into the form in a matter of seconds. They'll immediately get a personalized email signed by you the Grand Knight and encouraging them to join the Knights and reference your council by name and number.

The form will also auto-generate an email to you, which will give you all of the information given for each person that signs up, and it will enroll them in an email marketing campaign that will help tell them more about the Knights and what we do over time (Don't worry, they can unsubscribe at any time).

It's a great system! This can be a real game changer in the way we prospect. I would encourage every council to get out in front of this and request your own page immediately. The attached document explains it in more detail. All you need to do is go to info kofc.org/pagerequest.
