## *State Council News*

State Deputy Dave Quinn has announced that the State Per Capita has been suspended for the 2020-2021 Fraternal Year. This action was taken by the Board of Directors in recognition of the hardships caused by the current pandemic. This accompanies the suspension of the Supreme Per Capita for the current Fraternal Year. Please note that these suspensions do not apply to the following: Previous years State Per Capita, State Insurance Program (for those who participate), and the Supreme Culture of Life and Catholic Advertising assessments.

IPSD Mike Dziok announced at the August State Meeting that the Insurance Bills for the year, which normally go out in February/March, will be sent in the next couple of weeks and will be due upon

receipt. You can thank COVID for the delay.
