Here are the key tasks to complete as soon as possible

- Notify the parish
 - to request the date to celebrate the Our Marriage Prayer. Ideally this would be the weekend of World Marriage Sunday which is the second Sunday of February. The next World Marriage Sunday is February 10th, 2019. If this date doesn't work for your council, feel free to hold it on any weekend.
 - At least a week before the event, ask them to put a notice in the bulletin. A copy of one is included in this packet. Here is a link to the bulletin announcement <http://www.ourmarriageprayer.com/Portals/0/OMPEvent/Bulletin-Announcement-03.pdf>
- Although not necessary, ask knights to hold open doors for parishioners as they enter church. This really makes the event special and also gives the council a great image.
- Identify a knight who can lead the Our Marriage Prayer after communion. Enclosed is a copy of what they can say. Here is a link to the document <http://www.ourmarriageprayer.com/Portals/0/OMPEvent/Marriage-Prayer-in-Church-v3.pdf>
- Have the priest or parish administrator introduce the knights after communion. What they can say is enclosed.
- Ask knights to hand out the enclosed prayer cards after mass.
