- WHY?
 - Current State Membership (end of May) is 35,844
 - Average Membership Age in the State is getting younger...but we will have increasing declines in membership because of deaths over next 20-30 years
 - Membership 80 and over (18.13%), 70-79 (19.47%), 60-69 (22.44%), 50-59 (21.03%)
 - Less than 10% of our State's current membership is under the age of 40!!!

WHY?

- 20 years from Now...even if we cut suspensions in half every year...say we recruit/keep 1,500 members a year we will have recruited 30,000 Knights
- If all age 60-69 and older Knights are no longer with us (and we don't recruit a new member in this demographic) we will lose 21,622
- If all age 50-59 and older Knights are no longer with us (and we don't recruit a new member in this demographic) we will lose 29,159

 - Interim Young Adult Membership Coordinator (Corey Coonen-2018 Fraternal Year)
 - Goal: Identify Teams of Young Members to serve as our 'TACTICAL FORCE' Team within each Diocese
 - Identify a 'Leader' within the Diocese that will chair his committee of Young Adult Membership Recruiters.

Goal: This Leader will serve as the Future Membership
 Coordinator within his Diocese

Roll Out Program over the next 12 months

 Identify the Councils most in Need of Assistance with Church Drives. If no young member is available to do Pulpit Speech—a member from the Tactical Force team will attend and present

WHO? WHAT? HOW? (Trust the Process)

- Goal: Be Visible as a YOUNG, VIBRANT, FAITH FILLED organization serving our church, community and families
- Leaders within the Diocese will have monthly/bi-monthly huddles to evaluate the process, the successes and the need for any changes and adaptations needed
- Goal: We will evaluate on a monthly basis the trends of young members joining within the Dioceses and share with the State/DD's/Councils so that they can further embrace the process and developments and 'engage' our team for assistance when needed

WHO? WHAT? HOW? (Trust the Process)

Team

- 3-4 individuals under the age of 45
- Preferably 'ACTIVE' members in their Parish/Parish Schools/Community
- Comfortable with Public Speaking (would encourage them to develop their own Speech that is personalize to the Parish/Council)
- Time Commitment: Attend 1-2 Church Drives a Month and be visible on Social Media/Follow up with individuals and attend a monthly Recruitment Round Table (conference call) and inclusion in e-mail chains/group texts
