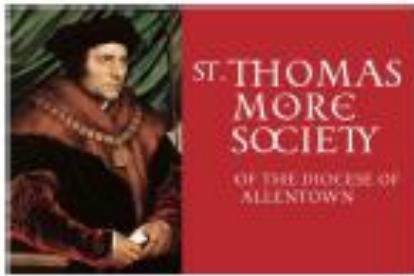

Archbishop Hebda earned his law degree at Columbia University, and a licentiate in canon law from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas (The Angelicum), in Rome. He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Pittsburgh on April 6, 1989. He served as an official at the Pontifical Council for Legislative Texts, 1996-2005, and as undersecretary of the council from 2005 to 2009, when he was named bishop of Gaylord. He was ordained bishop of Gaylord on December 1, 2009. He was named by Pope Francis as coadjutor archbishop of Newark on September 24, 2015.
