**Veteran Survey**

We did a quick and simple survey of our members to learn about their Veteran status.

We asked them to tell us if they

- Served on active duty
- Which branch of the service
- Served in Iraq or Afghanistan
- Served in a combat theater of operations

The results are:

Served on active duty	27
US Army	10
US Air Force	11
US Navy	5
US Marines	1
Iraq/Afghan	7
Combat Thater	16

The question on Iraq/Afghanistan was derived from another survey I came across. This seems redundant and I could have left it out.

I know we have (or had) veterans of Korea, WWII and other conflicts.

It is hard to list all the combat theaters. I have seen one list with over 50 combat zones, areas designated for hostilities or imminent danger pay.

What we would like to do is compile more data about our veterans and their service to our country.

We can use this information to better recognize and honor our veterans.

Supreme also has a program underway to identify and honor our veterans – see above.
