Homes For Our Troops is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to building mortgage-free, specially adapted custom homes for severely injured post-9/11 Veterans, with nearly 90 cents of every dollar donated going directly to program services.

The organization's primary goal is to build and donate specially adapted homes nationwide, tailored to each Veteran's unique needs, so they can rebuild their lives, focus on family and recovery, and regain self-sufficiency.

HFOT serves Veterans who have sustained life-altering injuries, including multiple limb amputations, paralysis, blindness, severe burns, and traumatic brain injuries. By providing a home designed for their mobility and accessibility requirements, HFOT enables Veterans to regain freedom, pursue careers, complete education, and engage with their communities. Veterans choose where to live, allowing them to remain close to family, medical care, and support networks.

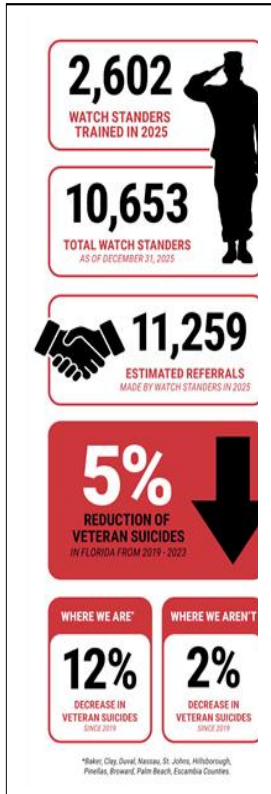
#### 2. Operation Warrior Resolution (OWR)

### 3. THE FIRE WATCH

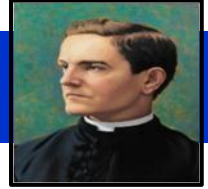


- San Damiano Assembly 3192 has trained **55 Sir Knights and spouses** as **Watch Standers**, earning us **Veteran Safe Place Certification Status** — the first Knights of Columbus Assembly in Florida to achieve this distinction
- The next step is bringing Watch Stander training to our own **3rd Degree Council** — we are requesting that **Brianne Brown** (or a designated Fire Watch representative) present a brief overview at the **April Council meeting**, followed by an **in-person training session in May**
- Sir Knights who wish to complete the training **online** through The Fire Watch website **may do so now** — any Knight interested should contact **SK Jack McGourty directly**, and he will provide specific guidance on how to access the course and ensure your name is added to our Assembly's official list of certified Watch Standers

### 4. EVERYDAY MONEY FOR VETERANS ON FIXED INCOMES

In partnership with Manatee County Veterans Services

- A four-session financial literacy program for veterans on fixed incomes — covering unclaimed VA benefits, cost reduction, credit and scam protection, and building a small emergency cushion; sessions held at the Manatee County Veterans Services offices in Bradenton; the Assembly is co-branded on the program
- The **May pilot runs May 14, 21, and 28 (11:00 AM–Noon)** — three sessions offered as a condensed introduction to what will ultimately be the full four-session curriculum
- **Mentoring Opportunity for Sir Knights:** Volunteer mentor opportunities are available — mentors may join **Live Sessions** at MCVV Headquarters supporting SK McGourty as he facilitates the program, provide **Post-Session Phone Consultations** to veteran participants who request additional support, and Sir Knights interested in either opportunity should **Contact SK Jack McGourty** directly

- **There are group pinnings that we have volunteered for including Goodwill Manasota for 40 Veterans on March 19<sup>th</sup>, several distinguished Veterans at the Red, White & Brave event in Punta Gorda March 26<sup>th</sup>, and Discovery Village on May 1<sup>st</sup>. We expect many more when we get closer to Memorial Day on May 25<sup>th</sup>.**
