On Tuesday, July 17th, 2023, San Damiano Assembly participated along with Tidewell Hospice in a 2nd VAVS tribute and pinning ceremony event at the Town Square Sarasota FL Adult Day Center to honor Veterans. The theme of the event was "Christmas in July" and featured the Manatee County Santa Drill Team who posted the colors, played military branch anthems, and presented each branch of the service flag. 3 Tidewell Hospice volunteer Veterans, Dennis Neal, Tom Althauser, and Sir Knight John Joly performed the pinnings of 18 Veterans including 2 Generals. (45 Veterans have been pinned in 2 events). There were approximately 70 people in attendance. The Veterans were accompanied by their caregivers, and all enjoyed a continental breakfast before the ceremony. The Adult Day Center at Town Square Sarasota is a 1950's themed senior center fully approved and funded by the VA! Veteran members move from one storefront to another throughout the day in groups with their Trained Program Assistants. Breakfast, lunch, and snacks are provided 5 days a week. Assistance is available for personal care needs and there is a full-time nurse present for medical management. There is no cost to the Veteran for these services! Caregivers also benefit by getting a needed respite break from a Veteran who is sick, disabled, old, or handicapped. There are additional VAVS opportunities for our Assembly at this location.

Air Force One Pilot on 9/11 To Recount Historic Missions

Despite the initial uncertanity on September 11,2001, it became quickly apparent the nation was at war. The first thought of Col. Mark W. Tillman, Commander and Pilot for Air Force One, was that his aircraft was parked on the tarmac in Sarasota and his President was a sitting duck. It was time to get airborne.

On September 13, 2023, Col. Tillman

will recount his experiences on 9/11 and in the days after, including a top-secret mission to Iraq on Thanksgiving Day.

The program is presented by Tidewell Hospice and Tidewell Honors Veterans in partnership with Tidewell Foundation. It is offered in tribute to our military veterans and first responders.
