In 2010, Ted switched to filmmaking after 20 years as a newspaper journalist. Since then he has produced seven documentaries, including one about Holocaust survivor turned global forgiveness ambassador Eva Mozes Kor. His most recent project is on Carl Erskine, the last-man standing of the Brooklyn Dodgers famed “Boys of Summer” and a longtime ambassador for diversity and inclusion.

Ted's documentaries have screened in film festivals worldwide and at the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, and have been featured in The New York Times and Forbes.com. “Eva: A-7063” aired on 95 percent of U.S. PBS stations and in Germany. “Undeclared: The Roger Brown Story” aired on ESPN Classic for several years. Ted holds a BA in American History from Princeton University and a Masters from the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University.

- The Silver Anvil award from the Public Relations Society of America.
- One of two "Program of Excellence" awards in 2020 from American Public Television, which encompasses some 350 PBS stations around the nation.
- The 2020 award for Top Historical Documentary from NETA (National Education Telecommunications Association), which encompasses 277 PBS stations.
