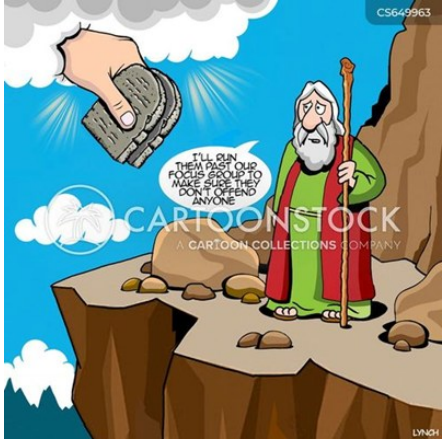
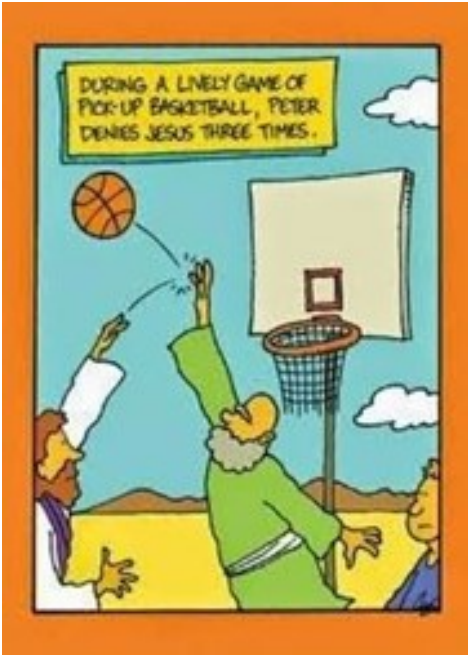

### **“3” Minutes of Daily Prayer”**

**3:00pm for Sir Knights, Spouses  
and Family**



Nearly every Sir Knight, spouse, family member or acquaintance desires prayers for guidance, inspiration, thanksgiving or petitions - minor or major. The Holy Spirit Assembly 3588 website has a readily available

PRAYER REQUEST portal of petition or thanksgiving. As faith filled Sir Knights, spouses and family members, we can be powerful daily

intercessors for these prayer requests. Jesus expired on the Cross at 3 PM for all sinners. 3 PM has long been considered the hour of mercy and many saints have encouraged 3 PM for reverently offering prayers. In fact, Jesus Himself said to St Faustina, "In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion...immerse yourself in prayer there where you happen to be, if only for a very brief instant." For the intentions in our PRAYER REQUEST portal, we invite you to pray daily at 3 PM **the Apostles' Creed, Our Father, 3 Hail Mary's, a Glory Be (The Trinity Prayer) and the Fatima Prayer. (Preceded and ended with the Sign of the Cross.)** The prayers will take 3 minutes of our time. Interestingly, if 400 Sir Knights simultaneously pray, the accumulation of 20 hours of prayer are then offered to our Heavenly Father in the name of Jesus. These prayers are the prelude to the 20 mysteries of the Holy Rosary of our Blessed Mother, Mary and provide the opportunity to recite a decade or an entire rosary, if time

permits. Remember scripture - Matthew, Chapter 18, Verse 20 states "For where 2 or 3 are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." This suggestion - enacted daily - assures a united prayer offered by our Sir Knights and others, together in His name.

# Monthly McGivney Message

If the strength of an organization can be judged by its founder, it is no surprise that the Knights of Columbus continues to grow in numbers and good works as it celebrates 144 years next week. Father McGivney laid a strong yet supple foundation, appropriate for its day yet open to change and challenges.

We need only to consider the words of those who knew him to discover his unique character. He was known for his orderliness and attention to detail as seminary sacristan, yet fellow students remembered best his sense of humor and easy laugh. His rector called him “exceedingly sensitive *usque ad lacrimas*” (“even unto tears”), yet as a priest, Father McGivney stood bravely at the gallows, reciting the prayers of the Church for a young murderer he had brought back to the faith. In a eulogy, a Knight said, “He was a man of the people,” zealous for the betterment of both their earthly condition and immortal souls.

As we observe the day the Connecticut legislature approved the charter of the Order – March 29, 1882 – let us ask Blessed Michael McGivney to continue to build up his Knights in charity, unity and fraternity.

## SUPREME CHAPLAIN MONTHLY CHALLENGE



### This Month's Challenge

April 2026

**Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread.** (Gospel for April 19, Lk 24:35)

The disciples on the road to Emmaus did not recognize Jesus until the breaking of the bread. Jesus promised he would be with us always, and the Eucharist is his fulfillment of that promise. We encounter his presence most profoundly in the Eucharist, where he is truly present — body, blood, soul, and divinity — under the appearance of bread and wine. The disciples' experience on the road to Emmaus was no ordinary meal, but an encounter with Christ, who invites us, too, to enter into communion with him through the Eucharist.

### Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to remain in prayer and adoration for several minutes after Mass to grow in awareness of Christ's true presence in the Eucharist.

### Questions for Reflection:

Do you fully realize it is the true body and blood of Christ that you receive in the Eucharist? Do you habitually pray in thanksgiving after Communion for this immeasurable gift? Do you consistently participate in Mass on Sundays and holy days? Do you make an effort to attend more frequently, so that you might avail yourself of the graces of this great sacrament?

## **Upcoming Election of Holy Spirit Assembly Officers (May 27) at Ascension Parish - MPR**

The election of Holy Spirit Assembly Officers for the 2026-2027 fraternal year will be held during the General Assembly meeting on Wednesday, May 27. All members in good standing are entitled to vote. All members must be present to vote.

All Assembly members are eligible to serve as officers. Nominations are being accepted now for all elected positions and will be accepted until the vote is taken at the May Assembly meeting at Ascension Parish MPR.

To nominate yourself or another member of the Assembly send an email message to the Faithful Navigator, Ron Meier and he will forward it over to the Nominations Committee. The Faithful email's address is [tsr.meier@gmail.com](mailto:tsr.meier@gmail.com) or call/text him at 314-409-1521. Please provide any qualifying attributes of anyone you nominate.

Listed below is a description of the duties of all officers – Navigator, Friar, Captain, Pilot, Admiral, Comptroller, Purser, Scribe, Inner Sentinel, Outer Sentinel, Trustees. Please note that, similar to Councils, the Friar and Comptroller are not elected positions.

The 1-year and 2-year Trustee positions will be filled by the current 2- and 3-year Trustees who will automatically roll up.

### **Duties and Responsibilities of Officers of a 4th Degree Assembly**

The Laws and Rules Governing the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus specifically set the duties and responsibilities of Assembly Officers. This guide is meant to help new Sir Knights and interested parties become informed about each position.

#### **Assembly Officer Position (Equivalent Council Officer Position) Position Description**

**FAITHFUL NAVIGATOR** (Similar to Grand Knight): The Faithful Navigator is the chief executive officer of the assembly and acts as the Presiding Officer, with all the powers and duties assigned to such office. He appoints committees, counter-sign orders and checks. He serves as the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and is an ex-officio member of all committees. He is responsible for establishing a Color Corps and annually appoints or reappoints the Assembly Color Corps Commander. He may perform such other duties as the Supreme Assembly may impose.

**FAITHFUL FRIAR** (Non-elected Officer; Like Chaplain): The Faithful Friar is the Spiritual Advisor of the Assembly. He is expected to make a report at Assembly Meetings on religious matters. The Faithful Navigator, Faithful Captain, Faithful Admiral, and Faithful Pilot appoint a Priest annually in accordance with such rules established by the Bishop of the Diocese to serve the Assembly.

**FAITHFUL CAPTAIN** (Similar to Deputy Grand Knight): The Faithful Captain shall, in the absence of the Faithful Navigator, perform the duties and exercise the powers of that office. He shall also, to ensure good attendance at meetings and other functions, have charge of social and other activities under the Good of the Order.

**FAITHFUL PILOT** (Similar to Warden): The Faithful Pilot shall have charge of all properties of the Assembly except monies, accounts and record books of the officers, but including ceremonials. He shall be responsible for arrangement of the Assembly Chamber and shall direct and be responsible for the activities of the Sentinels.

**FAITHFUL ADMIRAL** (Similar to Immediate Past Faithful Grand Knight): The Faithful Admiral shall preside in case of the absence of both the Faithful Navigator and Faithful Pilot. He may also perform other duties as assigned him by the Faithful Navigator. In the absence of the Faithful Friar, he performs his duties at assembly meetings.

**FAITHFUL COMPTROLLER** (Non-elected Officer; Like Financial Secretary): The Faithful Comptroller shall keep a roll and the records of the members with the date of their initiation in the Fourth Degree. He shall collect and receive all monies due to the Assembly and all funds obtained from any source and transfer the same to the Faithful Purser and obtain a receipt from him. He shall keep accounts of the charges and receipts of each member and issue to each member not indebted to the Assembly for dues, a Fourth Degree Membership Card. He shall upon request, by a member transferring to another assembly, issue a transfer card, signed by the Faithful Navigator and attested by the Faithful Comptroller. He shall keep such necessary Official Records and forms as furnished by the Supreme Secretary. He shall notify the District Master of the names of all candidates awaiting initiation. He is the custodian of the Seal of the Assembly and affixes the same to all proper papers.

**FAITHFUL PURSER** (Similar to Treasurer): The Faithful Purser is the custodian of all funds obtained from any source. He makes deposits and keeps records, pays for all orders drawn on him by the Faithful Comptroller and Faithful Navigator and makes records available to the Board of Trustees as required.

**FAITHFUL SCRIBE** (Similar to Recorder): The Faithful Scribe shall keep a record of the minutes of all regular and special meetings in a bound book furnished for that purpose by the Assembly.

**FAITHFUL INNER & OUTER SENTINELS** (Similar to Inside and Outside Guards): The Faithful Inner and Outer Sentinels shall be responsible to see that all in attendance at meetings are in possession of appropriate valid Third- and Fourth-Degree membership cards and shall perform such other duties as directed by the Faithful Pilot.

**3 TRUSTEES** (Similar to a Council's Board of Trustees): Together with the Faithful Navigator, Trustees serve as the Board of Trustees. The Board is responsible for auditing the record books of the Faithful Comptroller and Faithful Purser semiannually. Trustees shall perform other duties as directed by the assembly, assembly officers, District Master and Vice Supreme Master.
