The dinner took place at Allen Wickers on US 75 south of Parker in their private dining room from 6:15 to 9:00 pm. The dinner was preceded by an excellent appetizer buffet paid for by the council and we could order dinner from the entire menu. They also handled separate checks. Following the dinner I heard lots of compliments about both the entrees and deserts. The fellowship was fantastic and numerous new brothers and wives were able to attend. This was absolutely the highest number I've ever seen attend a dinner.

One downside to the evening was the timeliness of meals arriving, in many cases, was poor. I talked to the manager and learned his staff was short 2 cooks and 1 manager. He had planned the staff to be able to meet our needs but the required staff didn't show up. There was also another large unplanned party that showed up and filled the back part of the restaurant. 1 of our 3 assigned servers plus the manager ended up having to work in the kitchen to get meals out. The manager, wanting to ensure our satisfaction, offered to comp our entire party. I wouldn't let him do that. He said he'd provide free

dessert or comp any meal for those who were really upset. The servers and myself passed this information on. Adding to the problem at the end of the evening was their computer server went down and for a short while they couldn't process credit cards. They ended up processing many credit cards manually.

Even with the problems, the camaraderie and meals were good. The manager and staff did their best to make sure everyone was satisfied at the end of the evening. This restaurant should remain on our list and I hope that everyone will consider visiting them again.

Brothers, if you or your wives know of additional restaurants I should check out for future dinners please let me know. Thank you all for being there.


FALL BALL
