I want to thank our shoppers (Carol Goode and Marge Brennan). Marge used her JC Penney associate discount to really stretch the dollars (\$217 worth of merchandise for \$131). Carol and Marge also got together one night to wrap the gifts. The Ladies Auxiliary provided a \$150 Walmart gift card to help with food and other necessities. The mom had recently been laid off from a home health care firm and was working for Walmart when I first spoke to her. There was a time when she wasn't sure they'd still be in their apartment by Christmas. Since then she has interviewed for and accepted a new home health care position. Since the family had not celebrated Christmas for several years, they told Joyce they didn't have a tree or decorations. Three brothers (Tom Clarke, Fred Weber, and Jim Newberry) each donated a no-longer needed tree and others (Brennan, Victorine, and Goode) provided tree and Christmas decorations. The Squires also purchased and donated decorations. They should have plenty to decorate the tree and house for Christmas. One tree went to the family and the other two will be used on the Squires Christmas parade float and then be donated to other families in need.
