- **40 Days for Life** – The San Salvador Council was represented each Saturday morning during the Fall 2019 40 Days for Life Campaign at the Farwell Ave abortion facility in Milwaukee, offering prayerful witness to the Sanctity of Human Life. - **Holy Hill Ushering** – Thanks to all who volunteered to staff our annual ushering duties at Holy Hill on October 20th! It was a beautiful day at this amazing Shrine to our Lady.
- **Coats for Kids Drive** - Wow, what **amazing generosity** from Council members & SFB parishioners at our “Coats for Kids” drive on October 26/27.
