Easter Vigil was blessed with a beautiful evening with 20 new parishioners joining our church.

You may have heard by now that we will be getting a new assistant pastor in May. Here is an excerpt from Fr. Chris's email:

Fr. Leonard will be moving on May 1 to the parishes in St. Thomas and Meta to become the Administrator; Fr. Kelechi Uzuegbu, a Nigerian priest who has been assisting the pastor at the parishes in Macon and Bevier, will come to OLL May 1 to become Parochial Vicar (essentially Associate Pastor role); As with Fr. Leonard and other international priests, his stay with us will be relatively brief before he is assigned elsewhere in the diocese.

I have had early discussions with Fr. Chris concerning holding a "Special Needs Mass" on June 1 or June 2. Which Mass has not been decided. I will meet with Paul Fell soon and find out which Mass works best for him as well. We would fill needed ministry spots and have extra Hospitality slots filled by Knights to assist parishioners from and to their cars. A knight could volunteer to drive a homebound parishioner to church as well. Similar to our 5th Sunday program. The Mass time will be added to our website Event Calendar.
