 - **COVID Mask Project** – Ten members of the Council assembled 700 protective masks for distribution to vulnerable neighborhoods in Milwaukee.
 - **Rosary Novena for Seminarians** – Knights offered a 9-day rosary novena for Tim Schumaker and Michael Malucha to celebrate their ordinations to the transitional diaconate. We’ve supported both with scholarships thru the years and both are KCs. Congratulations Tim & Michael!
