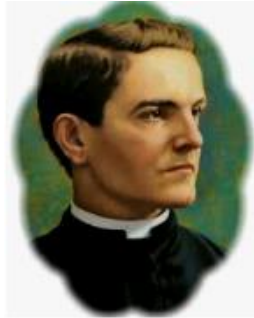

 - **Rosary Novena for Fr. Patrick** – On May 18th, our Chaplain, Fr. Patrick, celebrated his 7th anniversary as a priest. Knights presented him with a “Rosary Bouquet,” with members praying a Rosary daily for him from May 18-26.
