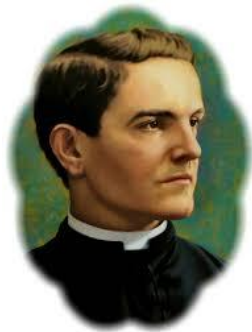

- **OCT 31ST IS FR. MCGIVNEY'S BEATIFICATION!** – Our Venerable Founder will be made a "Blessed" on Oct 31st at a ceremony at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford, CT. Fr. McGivney is a powerful intercessor for the unborn and for America. Fr. McGivney's beatification was approved following his miraculous healing of a baby in-utero in 2015. A second miracle would make him the first American-born priest to become a Saint.
