Mrs. Fay (shown below) then presented the Chalice to Father Archie to go with SK Jim Fays memorial.

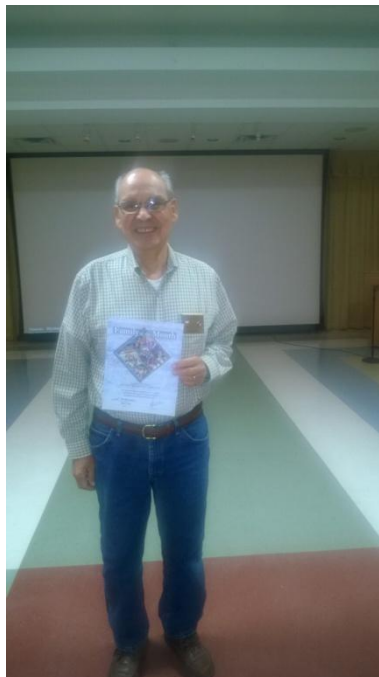
