GET TO KNOW YOUR BROTHER KNIGHTS BETTER

SK Bill Faucher says he is very proud to be the Grand Knight of Council 7613. Several Knights said they didn’t know much about him so we will now provide some good news regarding our new Grand Knight, SK Bill Faucher.

His father was in the Air Force and stationed at Johnson AFB Japan when Bill was born in 1949. Johnson AFB was a part of the Tachikawa air base in Tokyo. Bill was the oldest of 7 kids. As a kid he went with the family and lived in places such as Rome, NY; Syracuse, NY; Colorado Springs, CO; Sherman, Tx; Margate, England; Ramstein, Germany; and Westhampton Beach NY. In 1967, after graduating from Westhampton Beach HS he went to a prep school (Millard School) in Bandon Ore. While he was there his parents moved on to Phoenix Az.

He lived in Phoenix for about 2 months between completing Millard and starting at the United States Air Force Academy in 1968. He graduated from the Academy (Zoo) in 1972; married the love of his life, Kathy; and attended pilot training at Laughlin AFB in the beautiful Queen City of Del Rio, Tx.

He spent 4 years at Laughlin AFB City as he became an instructor pilot after graduation. His two girls, Jacqueline and Danielle were born there. After 4 yrs in Del Rio he was sent to Alaska and lived in Eagle River. He was flying the T-33 there and absolutely loved that state.

Next on the agenda was training in Tucson, Az to learn to fly the A-10 Warthog, and then off to England. Kathy and he lived in an old house in the town of Saxmundham in the province of East Anglia. More gorgeous country and we loved the history.

Then it was off to Ramstein AFB in Germany to be a staff puke. He hadn't been to a headquarters yet to pay his dues. After 2 years he managed to get sent to F-16 school in Tampa Fla and then back to Germany to Hahn AB. Now closed it is called Frankfurt West airport. He thinks that Ryan Air is the predominant carrier there. He and his wife Kathy thoroughly enjoyed their time in the Hunsruck part of Germany and became big fans of Moselle Reisling.

Their house was very close to Zell, Germany which is on the Moselle. Zeller Schartzkatze wine is one of their more famous products (but not the best). After three years of joy in Germany he took off to Misawa Japan to fly the F-16 there.

His son, William, was born at Clark AB in the Phillipines while Bill served at Misawa. Kathy got a special 2100 mile trip to the hospital for this. This was just before Mt Pinatubo blew and closed the place. The next stop, after almost 4 yrs at Misawa was San Antonio, Texas where he finally retired.

He started serving the church when he lived in England with his folks. He was an Alter Server who learned the Latin responses with a Latin speech record (33 1/3rd RPM, Long Play) so he could be a good server and beat the priest...was always a competition between alter

servers and the priest about how fast and correct you could make the response.

His mother was active in all the parishes they were in so, therefore, he was also active. While living in NY, Vatican II took place so he was the first lector for the church. He always remained active in the church and twice was a parish council president overseas. He has served primarily as a Lector and Lay Eucharistic Minister and here at St Marks he joined the choir which he enjoys immensely.

Serving is really a major part of his life and today he enjoys helping with Guadalupe Home and Habitat for Humanity. He joined the Knights in 2001. He served as Treasurer for 3 years, and Deputy for 1 year.

He does not have any real hobbies that he is dedicated to. He enjoys music immensely and at one time played clarinet and tenor sax. It would be a steep climb for him to get back that proficiency.

While flying he got tagged with a nickname, FOOSH. Sometimes he will sign an email that way out of an old habit.

He says that he is looking forward to these next couple of years towards helping to keep Council 7613 vibrant as ever by serving our parish and one another.
