Saint Joseph is one of the most beloved saints. As the patron of workers and the protector of the family, he is honored with a feast on March 19. According to legend, there was a famine in Sicily many centuries ago. There was an exceptionally severe drought in Sicily. No rain fell for an extended period of time, no crops would grow, and countless people died of famine. The villagers prayed to St. Joseph, Giuseppe (Joseph), Father of Jesus, and asked his intercession before the throne of God. Their prayers were answered. With the ending of the dreadful famine, a special feast of thanksgiving was held in commemoration of the Saint. This celebration became tradition. Families prepared huge buffets. They then invited the people of the village, especially the homeless and sick. Giving food to the needy is a St. Joseph's Day custom.
