

Council 13049 Council Meeting – 15 April 2021 Good of The Order Lecturer's Reflection



Brothers, for the month of April on behalf of our Grand Knight, Deputy Grand Knight and myself I'd like to engage you on two very important topics that affect our Council.

The first topic deals with our upcoming Council Elections. As you've already heard, at our next Business Meeting on the 20th of May, we will be holding elections for the Council officers' positions for the 2021/22 Columbian year. This is a time when we turn to our brothers and invite all to consider putting your name forward to take on a role within the executive. If you currently hold a position, we encourage you to either remain in this position or perhaps advance to a higher position. Keeping our Council's executive continually fully staffed also allows us to have a good succession plan in place for the future as well.

The second topic I'd like to raise with you concerns recruitment. As Supreme's website states, "Recruiting new members is essential to the continued growth and well-being of your council and the Order. Membership allows him to experience the fraternal bond that Knights share while growing closer to his family and his faith."
